CATECHISM OF THE WEEK

What is sanctification?

Sanctification is the work of God's free grace, whereby we are renewed in the whole man after the image of God, and are enabled more and more to die unto sin, and live unto righteousness.

KID'S LESSON

When I ask my kids to do something they don't want to do (like clean your room) - they 'll ask, "Why?" And I'll sometimes just say, "Because I said so." And they'll say back, "So?" And I'll remind them, "I'm your dad. I'm the boss. I'm in charge." And then they'll act like they're reminding me and say, "No, God is in charge. Jesus is our boss and Jesus is your boss." But I'll remind them, "Yes, Jesus is the boss of all of us. And Jesus made me your boss which means if you say you don't have to listen to me then you're really saying you don't have to listen to Jesus."

If you need an example just look at Jesus! The Bible tells us that when Jesus was a 12 year old kid he obeyed his parents. Even though when Jesus was a 12 year old boy, he tells his parents he already has absolute power over them. Even at 12 years old Jesus knew he was both fully God and fully man, AND he knew why he came down from heaven and was born as a baby - when he's just 12 years old Jesus knows that he came to live for us and to die for us to save us.

BUT, Jesus at 12 years old also knows that someone needs to obey in your place BECAUSE all kids fail to obey their parents like they should. This is why he goes home with his parents and submits to them as parents to fulfill the law FOR you. But Jesus knew his obedience would take him all the way to the cross to die for our failures, even our failures as kids.

But Jesus is risen and alive in heaven ruling over all. And Paul is going to tell us that Jesus has given us our parents to lead us by loving us and taking care of us - so the loving thing to do is to obey Jesus by obeying your parents.

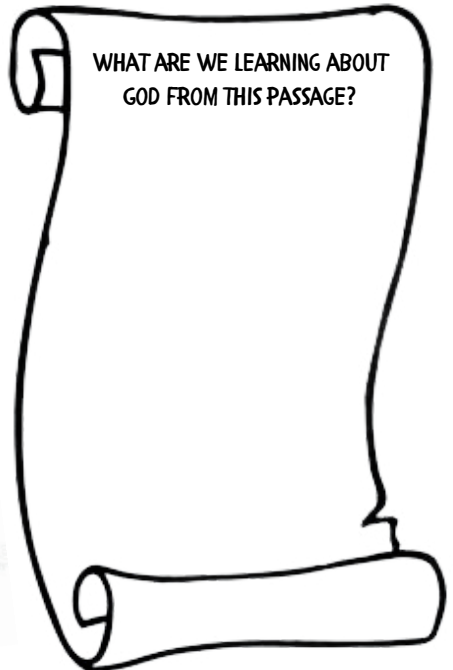
