# KID'S LESSON

## WHAT IS GRACE?

If a friend gets you something for your birthday - is that "grace"? It's definitely kind. It's definitely a "gift" but it's NOT grace.

If a stranger holds the restaurant door open for you - is that "grace"? Again, it's a kind thing to do but it's NOT grace.

But what if someone died for their enemy - is that "grace"? YES!

Grace is NOT unmerited favor - like one person does a favor for another person just to be kind.

Grace is DE-merited favor - like one person doing a favor for an enemy.

What do we deserve from God? Not blessing. Because of our sin we deserve cursing from God.

What does Jesus deserve from God? Eternal blessing because Jesus lived a perfect obedient life.

The amazing news of the gospel is that Jesus takes the punishment we deserve for our sin on the cross. BUT then God turns to us and GIFTS us what Jesus earned in his life. God GIFTS us what we don't deserve = heaven and eternal glorious life. That is GRACE = getting the opposite of what you deserve.

In Ephesians 2:1-10 the apostle Paul is going to tell us about God's amazing grace. God's grace is NOT this great blessing that you haven't earned. No, your problem is much worse and the gospel of grace is much better than that. Your problem is not that you haven't earned God's blessing. Your problem is that you have earned God's punishment with your sin. Grace is the awesome blessing of God which you have de-earned!

So how are you saved?

By believing in Jesus that he alone saves you. You are saved only by GRACE. You deserve hell but God by his grace because of Jesus gifts you salvation and heaven.

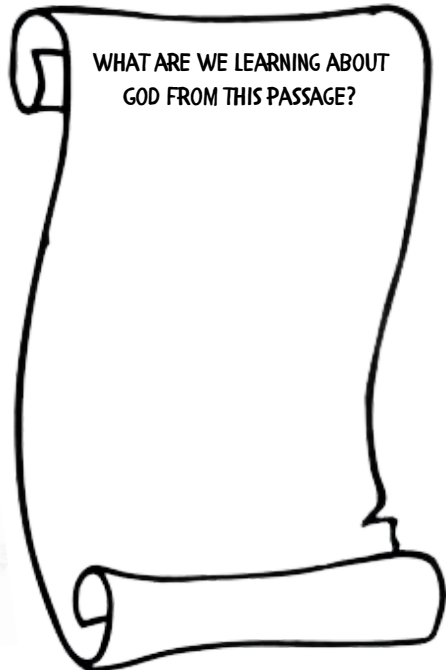
