KIDS' LESSON

Did y'all know there's all kinds of stuff in the world that you know is real but you don't know how it works? Water seems pretty simple right? Actually it's pretty complicated. Frozen water is what? Ice. And ice is cold and slippery. But no one knows why ice is slippery. Also no one knows why hot water freezes faster than cold water. And what does water taste like? How do bicycles work? What makes them stable? Gravity? We truly actually don't know. What are dreams and how do they work? Tickling hurts but you laugh - why? Why we do yawn and why is it contagious?

This morning we read Psalms 1 and 2 about how God runs the world. We know that God runs the world because the Bible says so but we don't understand HOW he does it.
