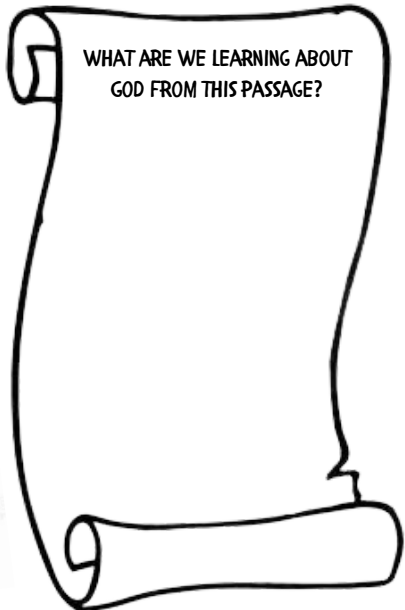

Find 15 differences between the two pictures below.

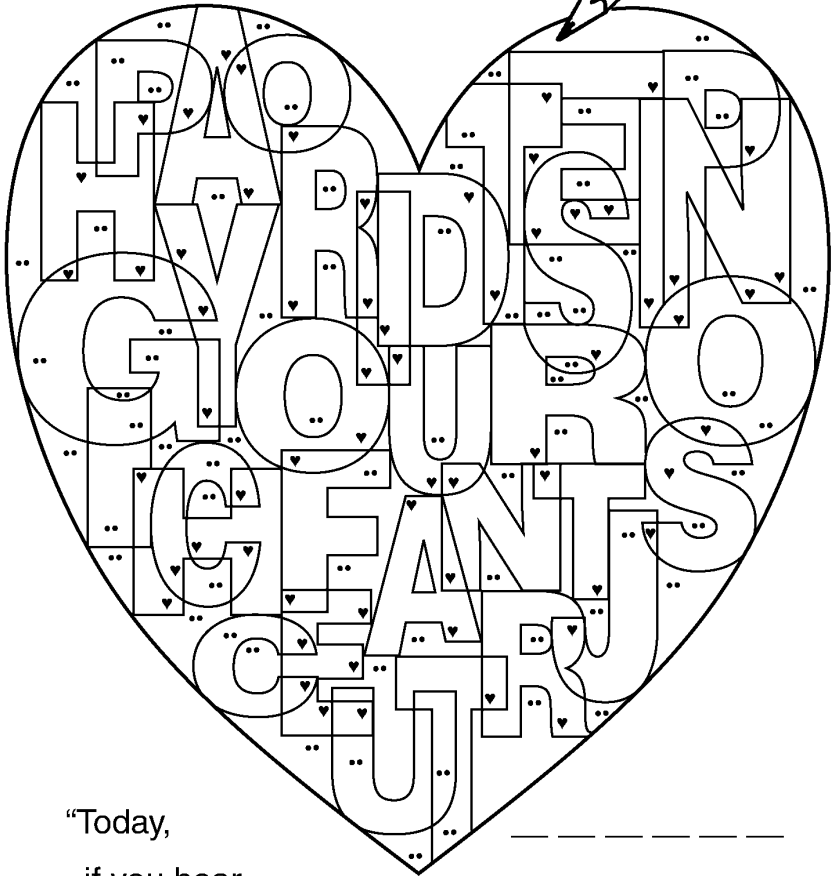
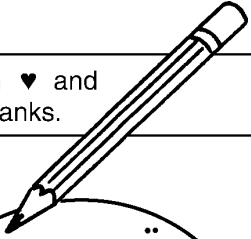


KIDS' CORNER
