But, when do you start to stop getting homesick?

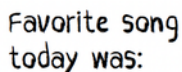
When your mom or dad pick you up! You start feeling back at home as soon as your back with your mom and dad because your mom, your dad - that's home.

And even though you've never been there - that's where Jesus is. And you know Jesus. He is your King, your Lord, your Savior. He came from heaven to live for you and to die for you to save you from your sin and death, because he loves you more than anything and he did it so that you can go home to heaven to be with him forever.

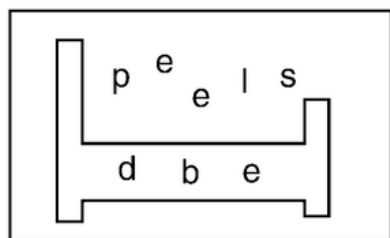
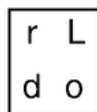
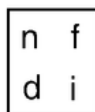
