The purposes of the Special Session shall be stated in a notice published not less than five days prior to the Special Session, and the Legislature shall not consider any other subject not within such purposes.

- 2. A Resolution to Authorize the Governor to Submit an Application to the Bureau of Indian Affairs to Place Title to the Hammon Ranch Tracts 2 (158.8913± acres), 3 (159.7665± acres), 5 (158.8406± acres), 6 (157.9078± acres), and 7 (428.3267± acres) in Roger Mills County, Oklahoma.
