These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by *Cheyenne and Arapaho Housing Authority*.

REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS

On or about April 8, 2026 the *Cheyenne and Arapaho Housing Authority* will submit a request to the HUD Southern Plains Office of Native American Programs for the release of the \$6,000,000.00 Indian Housing Block Grant Competitive FR-67-N-48 funds under Title I of the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996, as amended (NAHASDA) to undertake a project known as the Concho Low-income Rental Duplexes, which will consist of four (4) elderly duplexes and five (5) family duplexes on Tribal Trust property better known as the Concho Reserve in Canadian County, OK.

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The activities proposed *comprise a project for which a Finding of No Significant Impact on the environment was posted on March 20, 2026. An Environmental Review Record (ERR) that documents the environmental determinations for this project is on file at the Cheyenne and Arapaho Housing Authority 2100 Dog Patch Road, Clinton, OK 73601 and may be examined or copied weekdays 8 A.M to 5 P.M.*

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the *Cheyenne and Arapaho Housing Authority*. All comments received by *April 8, 2026*, will be considered by the *Cheyenne and Arapaho Housing Authority* prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The *Cheyenne and Arapaho Housing Authority* certifies to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development that *Damon Dunbar* in his capacity as *Executive Director* consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the *Cheyenne and Arapaho Housing Authority* to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development will accept objections to its release of fund and the *Cheyenne and Arapaho Housing Authority's* certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the *Cheyenne and Arapaho Housing Authority's*; (b) the *Cheyenne and Arapaho Housing Authority* has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to HUD Southern Plains Office of Native American Programs at 301 N.W. 6th Street, Suite 200 Oklahoma City, OK 73102. Potential objectors should contact U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
