The Constitution of the Cheyenne and Arapaho Tribes *Article VI, Section 5, subsection (a)* reads in part: *“The Legislature shall have the power to make laws and resolutions in accordance with the Constitution which are necessary and proper for the good of the Tribes.”*

Article VI, Section 6, subsection (a) reads in part: *“The Legislature shall convene in Concho for twelve Regular Sessions of up to two consecutive days beginning on the second Saturday of each month beginning at 9:00 am.”*

Article VI, Section 7, subsection (a) (ii) reads in part: *“All Bills shall be published in a legislative calendar for at least thirty days prior to action on the Bill. All Bills shall be made the subject of a public legislative hearing prior to action on the Bill.”*
