PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL DETAIL REGARDING ADDENDUM #3:

On Page 3 of Addendum #3, the answer to Question 11 can also be applied to out-of-state vendors and OEMs. Question 11 from Addendum # 3 is provided below for reference.

11. Question: The RFP requires respondents to have been in business for at least five years and to be licensed in both the City of Chicago and the State of Illinois. Our company has been in business in California for more than five years, and the applicable Chicago and Illinois business license applications are currently in process. Would IIPD accept evidence of the applications at the time of proposal submission, provided that the required licenses are obtained before contract award or issuance of a purchase order?

Answer: OEMs and vendors proposing to supply equipment only, without performing construction or installation work at IIPD, are not required to hold City of Chicago or State of Illinois business licenses under this RFP.
