Elections of Means of Receipt and Language of Corporate Communications

You may choose:

- (i) to read the Corporate Communication published on the Company’s website or The Stock Exchange of the Hong Kong Limited’s website (“**Website Version**”) instead of receiving printed copies; or
- (ii) to receive a printed English version only of the Corporate Communication; or
- (iii) to receive a printed Chinese version only of the Corporate Communication; or
- (iv) to receive both the printed English and Chinese versions of the Corporate Communication.

To contribute to the protection of our environment, we encourage you to select the Website Version. Even if you have chosen the Website Version, you reserve the right at any time by giving reasonable notice in writing to the Company’s share registrar, Tricor Investor Services Limited, to change your choice.

Please mark a “✓” in the appropriate box on the enclosed reply form (“**Reply Form**”) and sign and return it by post or by hand to the Company’s share registrar, Tricor Investor Services Limited at 17/F, Far East Finance Centre, 16 Harcourt Road, Hong Kong within 28 days from date of this letter. If you post your Reply Form in Hong Kong, you may use the mailing label in the Reply Form and need not affix a stamp on the envelope when returning your Reply Form. Otherwise, please affix an appropriate stamp.

If the Company does not receive a duly completed and signed Reply Form from you (or another response from you indicating that you object to receiving the Website Version of Corporate Communications) within 28 days from date of this letter, you will be deemed, until you inform the Company otherwise by reasonable notice in writing at the office of the Company’s share registrar at the above address or by email to 450-ecom@vistra.com, to have elected to receive all future Corporate Communications by Website Version instead of receiving them in printed form. In that event, when the Company makes a Corporate Communication, it will only send you a notification that the Corporate Communication has been made available on the Company’s website or The Stock Exchange of the Hong Kong Limited’s website. The notification will be sent to you by email or by post at your address as it appears in the Company’s register of members maintained by the Company’s share registrar.

You may at any time by reasonable notice in writing to the Company’s share registrar at the above address or by email to 450-ecom@vistra.com elect (i) to receive future Corporate Communications in printed form instead of by Website Version, or by Website Version instead of in printed form, or (ii) change the language in which you receive Corporate Communications in printed form. If you have elected (or are deemed to have elected) to receive Corporate Communications by Website Version and for any reason have difficulty in obtaining access to Corporate Communications on the Company’s website or The Stock Exchange of the Hong Kong Limited’s website, the Company or the Company’s share registrar will upon request send the relevant Corporate Communications to you in printed form free of charge.
