KARUAH RIVER RALLY IS BACK TO NORMAL !

Dear members

With vaccination rates approaching (or at) freedom levels, the Club is pleased to advise that we will be returning to a 'normal' Karuah in 2022 on:

Friday 11 February—Sunday 13 February 2022

It will be situated at the Frying Pan Creek campground as usual.

Things won't be quite a normal as we have decided to discontinue the catering for a number of reasons, so please **BYO everything** with your nearest supply point being Dungog about 31k away. If this situation changes we'll let you know. Cost will be \$25 (covering your badge and camping cost) and this hasn't changed for quite a few years now. There are two ways into the rally site with the easier one being the Main Creek – Skimmings Gap – Frying Pan Road. The other is the Wangat Trig Road past the Chichester Dam turnoff and across the Telegerry River Causeway (ending up on Frying Pan Road also). Both routes use Dungog as the start point (you don't really have to start there of course). There's about 14k k of dirt on both routes and if you are unsure of yourself on dirt, then take the Main Creek – Skimmings Gap road. And if the Telegerry River Causeway is flooding then definitely go the other way. We'll be getting a rally flyer out soon (we only just got approval from the Forestry Corporation to have the event). NOTE - if some emergency forces us to go somewhere else we'll try and let you know as early as possible.

For more details, check our Website or the Bank Hotel Dungog for a 'mudmap' to get you there or give Rob Lovett a yell on 0417 267 425.

Now, if you need a ride before then, have a think about our Karuah River Rally Recon Run to Dungog on Satur-

day 22 and Sunday 23 January. This is a traditional pub run which we have been doing for many years with its focal point being a dinner at the Bank Hotel on Saturday night 22 January.

There's plenty to do and see around Dungog and it's a great region for motorcycling. All you need to do is book the Bank Hotel (02 4992 1701), the Tall Timbers Motel (02 4992 1547), or the Royal Hotel Guest House (on 0418 443 398 - frontoffice@dungogroyalhotel.com.au). Note it can be a little warm in Dungog that time of year but its great socialising weather and you can swim in the Williams River or the local pool) and we'd love to see you there.

But wait there's more!! The Club also stages a camping event at Micalong Creek via Wee Jasper on New Year's Eve. Micalong Creek has to be one of the prettiest spots in NSW with the campground right on the creek surrounded by shady trees. You can decide if you'll ride or drive and a few of us drive and stay several days. It has safe swimming areas but again **it's byo everything** with nearest supplies at Yass. The 'core period' is Friday 31 December 2021 – Saturday 1 January 2022. If you'd like a badge, these will be \$15 (cost and postage). Bookings are essential so contact Wee Jasper Reserves on 02 6227 9626. Check their website where you can make an online booking. Have a think about this - we'd love to see you there.

Longer Lasting Airfilter R9T

I have just started using the Unifilter pre-filters on my R9T Urban GS, and thought I'd share the results.

As we often end up on a dirt road somewhere I wanted to help my air filter last. The air filters are a pain to change on these models. So after a bit of googling I found that Unifilter at Somersby do a kit of pre-filters with 2 x pre-oiled snorkel inserts that come in a ziplock bag for \$27.96 + post.

Put one in and cable tied it in place ready for a ride, 535klm day with roughly 120kim's of dirt thrown in. Surprising what they stopped and no reduction in performance.

Cleans up like a dirt bike filter in Mineral Turps, Soapy Water than re-oil with filter oil.

Matt Aderley and myself set off at 9.30am from Dubbo in overcast conditions. The wet weathers strapped on the back "just in case". Just in case happened 50kms out. This Adams family storm lasted 5 minutes. Struggling into the wet weathers, Matt said "well, with all the effort we may as well keep going". Continuing towards Mudgee with a spit here and a spit there didn't dampen our spirits.

As we were both on GS', Matt's R1150GS and my R80GSPD we decided to be a bit adventurous and turn off before Mudgee and head for Hill End via Hargraves. The windy roads are a nice change from the flat and straight roads around Dubbo. The scenery along this way was fantastic, the rain had previously cleared the air, the great depth of field with the mountainous green hills would have taken great photo's if one brought their camera along.

The dirt sections to Hill End were fairly quick 80-90kmh. Those R1150s look like they go great and with ease, though the R80 held her own just as well. With it drizzling and no others had arrived we decided to do the touristy thing and walk around the town. 20 minutes or so. Originally there were 52 pubs in the town along 10 miles of the Turon River. Plenty of watering holes to go to on the way home from trying to make a fortune panning for Gold.

After a bite to eat we headed for home via Ilford, Mudgee and Dubbo.

Matt & I both agreed to come back some time camping on the Turon with the family. Despite the rain we had a great day knowing most others would be at Philip Island or watching it on TV or too scared to come over the Big Hill to the west of the range.
