BMW Nine T Racer



When the Nine T emerged from the factory I was not particularly interested, mostly because in my little brain it should have been styled like an R90S. It seemed a competent enough motorcycle although some sections of the press labeled it underpowered and not value when compared with the latest UJM.

Various machinations followed the prettiest having an alloy tank. Still no cigars. Then the Scrambler which went back to tubed tyres and a suspension which is reported to be harsh. The rest of the machines are tech heavy and probably more than I want to contend with at my age(66). Seat heights good for the tall and electronic gizmos to make your eyes bleed do nothing for me.

And then I wandered into ProCycles and laid eyes on the Nine T Racer with a three quarter fairing and Motorsport colours. I sensed the moths gathering in my pocket. Everyone I've

shown the photos to (yes I took some) has agreed the R looks good.

The numbers are modest(81kW and 116Nm) however the outputs are more than satisfactory. Oh and it sounds bloody awesome from the chrome single sided muffler.

The machine is easy to point into a corner a flick into the next one. Conventional forks maybe the answer. ABS brakes the only technology oh and some heated handle bars. There is power a plenty from down low making overtaking a breeze. I think, in the right hands the machine would cause a bit of concern amongst the sports bikes on the Putty Road.

The riding position is not unlike the HP2, however with a seat height of 785mm (as opposed to 830mm) it's much more comfortable. If you have a big gut or bad back perhaps the stretch will cause you concern. At least it's an 18litre tank and not like placing a bowling ball in front of your nuts, like many modern bikes.

The Nine T Racer is only a solo, so this is the Sunday morning scratcher although I have no doubt you could do 1000km days on the bike. Much as I liked the machine after an extended test ride, it's unlikely I will purchase one, a dozen BM's is sufficient.

Do yourself a favour and ride the Nine T Racer. If this machine had emerged before the HP2 I would have been happy.

Dear Alan;

You probably heard that my K1100LT has finally exited the building, I know I know it's been languishing in the garage for months and I have been piloting the good ole 84RS (K100) which you know is the most reliable beastie this side of the Siegfried line....now

as you remember I was keen to get a newer and more capable ride, something with a little more cover for those chilly Richmond/ Bells line mornings and even more so for the "long ride" to Tassie come October so I looked at the usual places 20 year old tourers live and there were so many choices and fortunately the K bike heritage meant that kilometreage (Is that a word?) meant nothing. I

found many that were relatively un molested I don't mind seeing Beemers going on forever but do whince when a perfectly good machine gets cut to pieces but in my case I found an ex NSW police ride that was owned by the original rider for many years with a pretty reasonable conversion to non police looking unit gun metal grey with 120K on the



clock...of course the kilometres on the clock may or may not be genuine although the smaller than usual increments mean it was on a police bike once and the extra ABS lights mean a late model K...16 valve. Anyhow since BMW riders are totally trusted individuals I purchased her by photos only and she was delivered to my


place as the owner was on the way to another location on the other side of nowhere. The price was reasonable and less than half of the insurance value so I had to ride her straight away and as expected an extra 100 CC torque pushed the big German almost effortlessly

265KG is really obvious at slow speeds but nothing when rolling I like the electric windscreen up

and down up and down strange though at full extension no wind in your face but from behind your head pushing you forward so jiggle up and down till I hit the sweetspot....curious how long before the thing goes twang and stops working but fortunately the K75 model is the same and relatively plentiful so got a couple of spares....did I mention I hoard spares just in case(*you are not alone John, shh*) and love a bargain so when an ex rid-

er ...yes there are some...wants to sell the lot for a token amount I get lots of interesting stuff plus the original thing I wanted. Now down to tin tacks best check this beastie for all the usual (as per internet) problems on the K1100LT so steering head bearing check get my son to sit on pillion whilst on centre stand and yep clunk clunk clunk around the mid position...ok Motobins and Motorworks price check and of course Munich to reinforce why I buy lots from the UK...lets see what else I can see oh bugger fork seals leaking just a little so add that to my checkout list oh that's nice one of the fork stanchion bolts is missing...add one of those too...mmmmmm. That was fun not so difficult I really enjoy knowing its ok now with the right fluid. Now what else had I read about these as nothing has ever been that

wrong on the K100RS other than water pump oil pump combo change and this one looked fine no dribbles out the drain hole...cool!!! Apparently these K1100's had an issue with the exhaust cracking these were all one piece welded together unlike the K100 which never had an issue...the problem is that the exhaust weighs a ton and is supported by a bracket and rubber bush attached to the centre stand which in this case was fine...I have a spare exhaust care of the job lot arrangement I mentioned earlier which I may fit to the K100 as they fit and look great as they polish up amazing all stainless...hence the hefty weight. Now what another trouble area oh yes ABS mmmm why do BMW bother they are really crap at ABS there is an old joke that asks what colour bucket do you keep your ABS system in (apparently the yellow bucket is the preferred colour)

...of course the lights are flashing everywhere on the ABS and the reset does not work.....resoldered the ABS switch and reset the ABS unit by earthing the centre post of the BMW test connection and voila she is fixed. NEXT!!!!

Now I checked underneath the bellhousing for want of a better term and sure enough a little dribble of engine oil which is a sure sign that either the rear main seal or oil O-ring under the clutch had stopped doing its job so after a road test yep there was slippage at the clutch especially if I gave her a wrist full in top gear.... What's the term "variable noise constant speed" ok best read up on this or spend a third of the value of the bike getting it done. I started to pull the acres of plastic off her and found so many things that were not done well or worn or broken etc etc....I ordered all the clutch bits

and main seal and o-ring and clutch bolts. Now here is where Christmas hit and I went back to riding the 84RS and the 1100 sat with its bum in the air on a wooden horse for months as parts were stacked up and I forgot where things came from and how things went back together....huge hint take far too many photos as they are worth gold when you need to refit stuff. I received my rego renewal and had a limited amount of time so hooked in with pictorial assistance from fellow K owners and verbal advice too...anyhow she is all back together now and looking pretty good although I now hear what sounds to me to be a loose timing chain so that will be next when it arrives from the UK....this is what parents call bonding and I am looking forward to enjoying this youngster as much as my 33 year old.
