EDITOR'S RAMBLINGS

G'day all.

We're back!

Big miles lately. 11,500km in 7 weeks.

The OCR was lots of riding, no sightseeing except for the scenery going by, & no beds.

10,500km, 24 nights in the swag, only 3 lay-days.

13 X 500km days going up, plus one day off in Alice Springs. One day & two nights at Drysdale Station for the meeting, Coming home included a lay-day at Kununurra, & 8 X 600km days home. The last day from Dalby home was 1000km.

About 110 people made it to Drysdale, 60km northwest of the Gibb River Rd, & about as far from Sydney as you can get.

A few hard luck stories, including a burnt BMW, Lissa with a defunct rear shock, a DR rider hit a wallaby & broke his ankle.

George Scarfe going bush without contact for 4 days & having family in panic & the cops looking for him, & his Honda Dominator, with about 6 breakdowns, the last one terminal, & him buying a ute in Port Hedland to truck the Dommie home. His comment? What a great trip!

Bikes went very well. Paul's Yamaha XT660 had a leaking fork seal, & needed a new chain by Mount Isa. Andris's BMW Cross Challenge was a surprise. It went very well, with no



mechanical issues. Andris-made pannier rack succumbed to vicious corrugations & needed some welding & a piece of 3x2 timber to give extra support. He did the submarine thing with it on the Pentecost River crossing, & needed about 4 hrs to get the water out.

My KTM 690 had no major issues except for very lean mixture causing surging & stalling at low revs. Apparently the open exhaust pipe exacerbates the lean running.

Hard to believe how well they stood up to the pounding from the corrugations.

Gravel quarries make excellent camping sites! Within 200m of the road, a berm of topsoil pushed up around the perimeter gives privacy & a windbreak, there's acres of clear ground with little or no grass, & plenty of firewood in the timber that's been cleared with the topsoil. We used them about 10 times.



Paul has been having trouble with his eyes, & was doing it pretty hard on the loose sandy



sections. We got him up there to the meeting, but he didn't want to do any more dirt, so we slabbed it home, forgoing the planned dirt route across to Normanton & down.

It rained at Longreach the night before we got there, so any idea we may have had of doing dirt roads went out the window from there on anyway.

So, the trip of a lifetime? Yes, but I hope to do many more before I quit.

I'll do a longer report with pics etc. in the next month or so.

The next OCR in 2016 will be at Mungerannie, 209km up the Birdsville track from Maree.

Then the Far Cairn.

Perfect weather, good attendance of about 165, great company, great roads, and I'm out in the country. What more could one ask?

Andrew LeLeivre, past Pres & the initial proposer of a rally at the centre of NSW, travelled out with Paul & I & Chris & Claire Huddy.

I was impressed with Huddy's Leadwing! As usual we have a bit of a blat up Kurrajong, & I got covered with soot as he opened the taps, & though he didn't produce any sparks from the footplates, I almost couldn't keep up on my trailbike! Doesn't say much I spose.

Thanks go to everyone who helped make this another successful Far Cairn.

Riders simply fill in a Change of Vehicle Particulars Notification Form F3524 at their Qld Transport office for pro-rata refund of the difference. (CTP not included).

The bike needs to have a seat no longer than 500mm, & have the pillion footpegs removed.
