



## **Feed-in Tariff (“FIT”) Review Q2 2026**

### **Decision & Order**

Date: 27 March 2026

The Electricity Act 2016 (**EA**) requires the Regulatory Authority of Bermuda (**RA**) to set a pre-determined rate at which renewable energy is purchased by the Transmission Distribution & Retail Licensee from a distributed generator, for a predetermined period, and under pre-determined conditions in accordance with Part 6 of the EA (**Feed-in Tariff**).

Section 36 of the EA requires the RA to determine the Feed-in Tariff in accordance with the methodology which was set by the RA in the Regulatory Authority (Feed-in Tariff Methodology) General Determination dated 28<sup>th</sup> September 2023 (**Methodology GD**).

The RA has revised the Feed-in Tariff rate in accordance with the Methodology GD and section 37(b) of the EA. The FIT reflects the calculation based on the avoided costs of generation, and economic/social benefits, incorporating forward-looking assumptions. The revision is further explained in the FIT Public Report (Q2 2026) issued by the RA 27 March 2026.

The RA hereby sets the Feed-in Tariff at \$0.10726 per kWh, effective 1 April 2026.
