Exploring the core mission

Before mapping the itinerary or confirming the speakers, we co-designed the ambition.

The program was built around three transformational pivots:

- Expose leaders to credible, enterprise-grade AI where ROI and governance are visible now.
- Map agents + data infrastructure to heavy-industry workflows (safety, maintenance, AR, emissions)
- Accelerate alignment: leave with 30/90-day account actions and alliance next steps.









Each visit, each voice, each session was chosen to spark new thinking and challenge old assumptions. Together, we decoded how world-class companies are navigating disruption.

We dissected how corporations like **Nvidia and Microsoft** are operationalizing Al.

We saw how **DevRev**, **Crew.AI**, and some of a16z's premier portfolio companies are designing intelligent services and experiences from the ground up

We engaged in raw, **behind-the-scenes discussions** on culture, speed, and transformation—with peers who've lived it, scaled it, and are still iterating

Crafting the **storyline**

Monolithic apps → Orchestration layers → Agentic work

The arc progresses from ecosystem signal (VC + HAI) to agent platforms and enterprise scale (hyperscalers, compute), ending in concrete commitments by account.


Why Silicon Valley was the **obvious choice**

Behind closed doors

Handpicked by a16z for this executive cohort, four portfolio leaders offered closed-door depth.

Crux showed how finance-grade data and transaction rails channel capital into decarbonization—tax credits to structured energy deals. ElevenLabs demonstrated enterprise voice AI that localizes tone, language, and compliance in real time. HappyRobot revealed agentic operating systems that automate end-to-end workflows across logistics and service. Stuut unpacked AI-native finance operations—AR, cash application, dispute resolution—plugged directly into ERPs and banks.

Together, the sessions mapped a pattern: agents + data + governance turning AI from demos into operational infrastructure across energy, mobility, and industrials, with pathways to measurable ROI.

Decoding the Al index report

Nestor Maslej, Research Manager at Stanford's Institute for Human-Centered Artificial Intelligence (HAI) and lead author of the AI Index, provided a data-driven assessment of global AI progress. Drawing from the AI Index and HAI's Global AI Vibrancy Tool, Maslej outlined trends in research, investment, and governance, revealing how nations and corporations are racing to establish leadership positions.

Nestor's insights provide a macroeconomic lens. They affirm the opportunities that exist to help governments and global enterprises close the "Al governance gap"—through standards, audits, and cross-sector frameworks that enable responsible and inclusive adoption.

AgentOS for Enterprises in practice

Behind closed doors, DevRev unpacked AgentOS—their product-to-revenue operating system—for this executive cohort. CEO Manoj Agarwal showed how product signals, customer conversations, and support workflows converge in one data model, enabling Al agents to triage issues, suggest fixes, trigger follow-ups, and surface expansion opportunities with humans in the loop. We explored governance controls, audit trails, and role-based guardrails designed for regulated, enterprise environments. The discussion moved from demos to deployment patterns: which data to connect first, how to phase pilots, and what good looks like in cycle-time, CSAT, and cost-to-serve improvements.

A rare, practical view of Al-native operating models at enterprise scale.
