

Children's Services Council Capacity Building Grant

A Capacity Building Grant from the Children's Services Council of Broward County supported a strategic partnership with Grey and Associates to strengthen organizational infrastructure and leadership. Through this initiative, GIC developed a comprehensive strategic plan, engaged in targeted board training, implemented DISC assessments to enhance leadership effectiveness, and established a CRM system to improve volunteer management. This investment significantly advanced operational capacity and positioned GIC for sustainable growth and long-term impact.



Southern Black Girls Dream Conference



GIC participated in the Southern Black Girls and Women's Consortium (SBGWC) annual Black Girls Dream Conference in Atlanta, GA, providing four Sunflowers from Florida the opportunity to engage in a powerful, youth-centered convening focused on leadership, wellness, and dreaming boldly. The experience exposed the Sunflowers to dynamic workshops, peer connection, and affirming spaces designed to support Black girls' voices, aspirations, and personal development, further expanding their horizons beyond their local communities.



Scholarships



The 2025 Annual Scholarship Fund raised \$3,163 to support the educational journeys of 10 Sunflowers. These funds directly impacted Sunflowers currently enrolled in college and provided significant milestone awards to two graduating senior Sunflowers, each receiving \$1,000 to support their transition to higher education. This continued investment reflects our unwavering commitment to academic achievement, access, and long-term success for the girls we serve.



Girls Giving

As part of our commitment to service, our Sunflowers participated in a meaningful community service activity that emphasized compassion, teamwork, and giving back. Through hands-on engagement, the girls learned the value of serving others while making a positive impact in their community. This experience empowered our Sunflowers to lead with kindness, responsibility, and purpose.



Giving Tuesday

For the first time, GIC participated in Giving Tuesday with a fundraising goal of \$5,000. With overwhelming support from donors and community partners, the campaign surpassed its target and raised \$6,580. This achievement marked a significant milestone, demonstrating community collective investment in our mission and future impact.
