RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Upon competing in the TPF pageant, contestants ages 4 and up cannot be a reigning queen of any fair or festival. Ages 4 and up are contracted titles with the TPF. Ages 0-3 are not contracted royalty but will be invited to join for some events.
2. Age groups: 0-11 months, 12-23 months, 2-3, 4-5, 6-8, 9-11, 12-14, 15-17, 18-23
3. Miss contestants must be between the ages of 18-23 years, never married, have no children or pregnancy, and must be born female.
4. The TPF pageant is open to the following parishes: Tangipahoa, Livingston, Washington, St. Tammany, and St. Helena
5. Stage set up is 3 x's straight across. You may model them any way you like. If you are looking at the stage, you will enter from the right exit left
6. One picture of each contestant may be entered to compete for the most photogenic award. No larger than 8X10. Please label the back of the photo with your child's name and age. Turn your picture in during registration at the pageant. do not mail. No frames. Pictures may be picked up from the registration table after the division has been crowned.
7. Ages 0-8 is Sunday's best attire - light makeup. Ages 9 and up is pageant wear- full hair and makeup, no hair falls, wiglets, or flippers.
8. **The Teen and Miss division will introduce themselves on stage before modeling.**
9. There will be a 20-contestant limit per age group. Entries will be taken at registration as long as the group is not full. We suggest arriving early or mailing in your registration fee.
10. There will be a **mandatory meeting for Miss contestants.** The meeting will be held on **October 9, 2025**, at the Tangipahoa Parish Fairgrounds at 6:00 pm. Please arrive on time and be prepared to take a group photo. Please bring your *printed* bio and registration fee. **There will be no entries for Miss contestants accepted at the door.**
