The Limits of One-to-One EDI

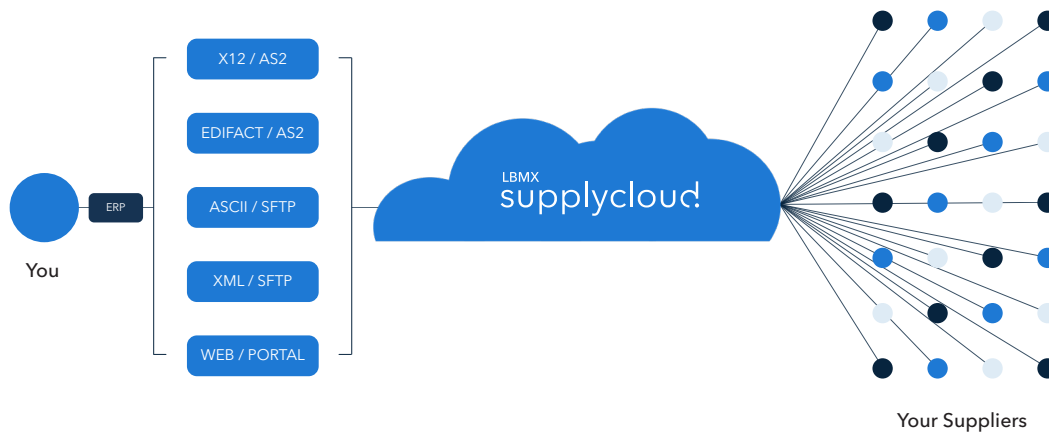
