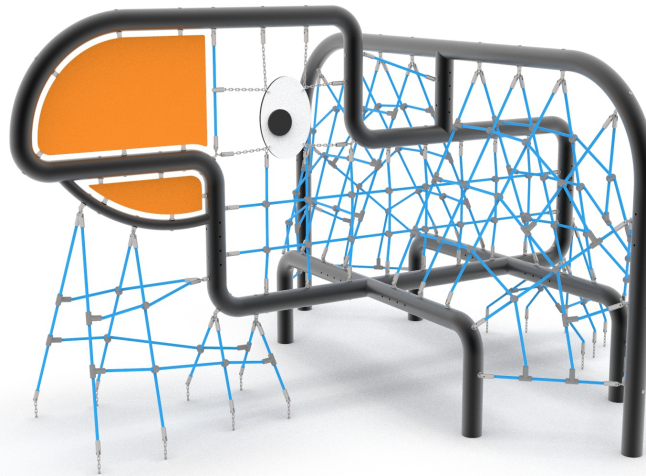

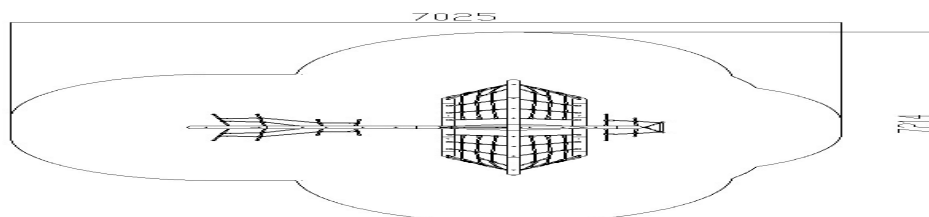

Structure of Ø114.3 mm tube, hot-dip galvanised and powder-coated

Ø16 PP rope with steel core

Galvanised calibrated technical chains

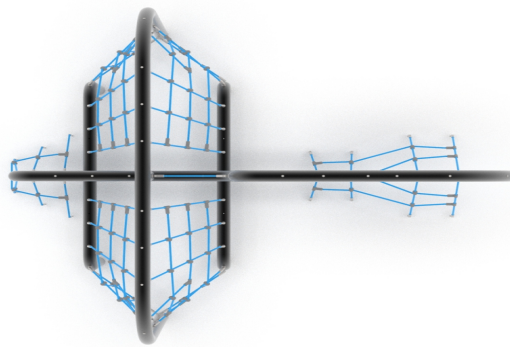
Coloured HDPE panels

Aluminium and high-quality plastic connectors
