Materials & Construction

Body: etched stainless steel resonating box

Sound: built-in snare tone at the top, bass tone around the middle

Use: played by hand while seated; doubles as outdoor seating

Mounting: ground fix as standard; surface-fix version available

Sound level: approx. 70 dB under 3 m · 54 dB at 10 m · 45 dB at 50 m

Siting: site in shade or facing away from the sun – steel can get hot enough to burn in direct sunlight

This product is played from ground level and is not designed to be climbed, so impact-absorbing surfacing under BS EN 1177 is not required. Keep the recommended free space clear around the instrument.

The equipment shown is a representative image only; the actual product will look similar. Colours and finishes may vary from those shown. Dimensional tolerance +/- 5cm.

Why Choose This Product

The outdoor cajon is a hard-wearing take on the traditional Peruvian box drum. In place of plywood, the resonating box is made from etched stainless steel for year-round outdoor use. Players sit on the drum and strike the front face – a crisp snare sound near the top and a deep bass tone around the middle. Robust and vandal-resistant, it suits streetscapes, youth spaces and less supervised areas, and several cajons together make an instant drum circle.

- Doubles as seating – play it where you sit
- Snare and bass tones from a single drum
- Vandal-resistant stainless steel for less supervised spaces
- Position in shade to avoid hot surfaces in direct sun
