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Materials & Construction

Chimes: 16 hand-tuned aluminium tubes, pentatonic tuning across three octaves (C3–C6)

Mallets: supplied – two large pairs and one small pair

Mounting: ground fix as standard; surface-fix and wall-mounted versions available

Construction: vandal-resistant, for permanent outdoor installation

Sound level: approx. 88 dB under 3 m · 59 dB at 10 m · 51 dB at 50 m

Access: wheelchair accessible from ground level

Siting: avoid direct sunlight; confirm free space in the site risk assessment

This product is played from ground level and is not designed to be climbed, so impact-absorbing surfacing under BS EN 1177 is not required. Keep the recommended free space clear around the instrument.

Symphony Freechimes bring rich, harmonious sound to school playgrounds, outdoor classrooms and community spaces. Sixteen hand-tuned aluminium chimes span three octaves of the pentatonic scale, so every combination of notes sounds good together – there are no wrong notes. The long frame lets several players make music at once, encouraging creativity, listening and shared play, and every note can be reached from a wheelchair.
