

Participation Agreement for ev.energy Control Group Program

Thank you for your interest in joining Knaresborough Community Energy Share Trial (the **"Program"**).

This Program is brought to you by the Knaresborough Community Energy Limited, the Condor consortium (**"Trial Consortium"**), and ev.energy Corp. (**"ev.energy"**).

Your participation is completely voluntary. By continuing to use the ev.energy app (**"App"**) or participate in the program via the web portal you agree to the terms below including the Privacy Policies referenced below.

1. What's the Program About

This Program encourages electric vehicle (**"EV"**) drivers to enroll in the charging program through incentives. These incentives may include financial rewards or other benefits, depending on your location and eligibility. ev.energy will use the App to collect information about your EV charging, such as:

- When and where you charge
- How much energy you use
- Your vehicle's make/model/trim, vehicle identification number (VIN), battery size, charger make/model, charger serial number or other unique identifier, vehicle battery state of charge, plug-in/unplug times, start/stop times of charging sessions, kWh of energy consumed, vehicle charging location and similar data, and charging equipment

(**"Collected Data"**).

This helps us evaluate the Program. Additional data (e.g., connected hardware metadata, vehicle location, technical data and application usage data) may be stored and processed by ev.energy in line with ev.energy's Privacy Policy for the purpose of administering the Program, but this data will not be shared with the Trial Consortium

The incentive is as follows:

- You will earn £0.22 per kilowatt-hour of charging completed at the Chapel Street car park in Knaresborough, during the notified hours of community energy sharing.
- You will earn £10 once you sign up, onboard, and complete your first charge at the Chapel Street carpark during the notified times. This must be before the trial end in September 2026

The incentive payment is processed by the Electric Places, a Trial Consortium member, once you have provided details of your nominated account for receipt. There is no other compensation offer in place of the above incentive.

2. Who's Involved

ev.energy: provides the App, and captures and processes your data as requested by Trial Consortium and we issue the incentives

Trial Consortium: evaluates the results

Even though Knaresborough Community Energy Limited is part of the Program, you may only see ev.energy branding in the App.

The Trial Consortium includes the following organisations, which are required to deliver the trial:

3. Your Participation

To take part, you must:

- be at least 18 years old
- not participate in the Program in any way that is illegal, fraudulent or abusive, including to harass, threaten, abuse, defame or slander any individual
- own or use a supported EV as set out here: <https://www.ev.energy/drivers/integrations>.

You may need a paid telematics subscription from your EV manufacturer to participate. These costs are your responsibility.

4. What You're Agreeing To

By participating, you agree that:

- Your data can be shared with ev.energy and Trial Consortium for program-related purposes
- ev.energy and Trial Consortium are not responsible for losses, damages, or technical issue
- You have permission from anyone else using the EV to collect and share this data.

6. Privacy and Data

7. Term and Leaving the Program

We envision that the Program will continue through 31st September 2026. You can opt out at any time by emailing us at support@ev.energy.

ev.energy or Knaresborough Community Energy Limited may also remove you from the Program if you stop meeting the requirements or are no longer actively participating.

8. Participant Feedback and Data Collection

You will cooperate in good faith with the Trial Consortium and ev.energy or its and their authorized representative in performing evaluation, measurement, and verification of the Program. The Trial Consortium and ev.energy will use Collected Data to evaluate the Program and for future planning purposes, including, but not limited to, assessing your experience, measuring potential savings to you, avoiding energy distribution and/or supply costs to the Trial Consortium and ev.energy, and reducing emissions. Additionally, the Trial Consortium and ev.energy may request that you complete surveys during and after the conclusion of the Program. The Trial Consortium and ev.energy may use and publicize anonymized quotes from your surveys in promotional materials.

9. Indemnification

You agree to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless ev.energy and the Trial Consortium, and each of its and their members, officers, officials, agents, and employees, from and against any and all loss, liability, expense, claims, suits, and damages, including attorneys' fees ("**Claims**") to the extent arising out of or resulting from your participation in the Program.

10. Assignment

This Agreement is personal to you. You may not assign or transfer rights or delegate obligations under this Agreement. The Trial Consortium and ev.energy are permitted to assign this Agreement, in whole or in part, to any person, at any time, and without notice to you.

11. Taxes

You are responsible for paying all taxes, if any, associated with receipt of incentives or any other thing of value in connection with the Program.

12. Entire Agreement

This Agreement (including any other documents or policies incorporated by reference) constitutes the entire agreement between you on the one hand, and the Trial Consortium and ev.energy, on the other hand, with respect to the Program and supersedes all prior or other arrangements, understandings, negotiations and discussions, whether oral or written, with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement.

13. Modifications to this Agreement

Ev.energy and the Trial Consortium may modify this Agreement at any time. Please ensure you check this page periodically. By continuing to take part in the Program after any changes are made, you agree to any updated terms of this Agreement.

14. Waiver/ Severability

No waiver of any provision of this Agreement shall be deemed or constitute a waiver of any other provision of or any subsequent breach of this Agreement. No waiver shall be valid unless made in a writing signed by the party granting the waiver. If any provision in this Agreement is declared invalid or unenforceable, then such provision shall be severed from the remainder of this Agreement, which will otherwise remain in full force and effect.

15. No Third-Party Beneficiaries

This Agreement is for the benefit of ev.energy and the Trial Consortium and each and their respective successors and assigns with respect to your obligations under this Agreement and for your benefit with respect to your rights under this Agreement. There are no other third-party beneficiaries under this Agreement and this Agreement will not be deemed to confer upon or give to any other person any claim or other right or remedy.

16. Law and Venue

This Agreement shall be interpreted and enforced in accordance with the laws of the United Kingdom without reference to its principles on conflicts of laws.
