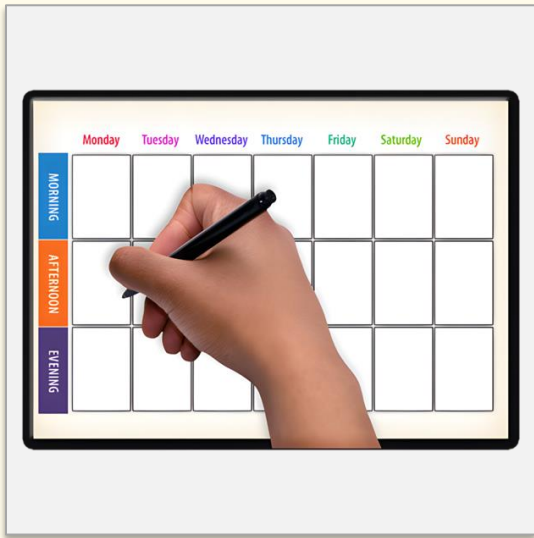
A curfew is a rule that says you must be home at a certain time and stay there until a certain time.

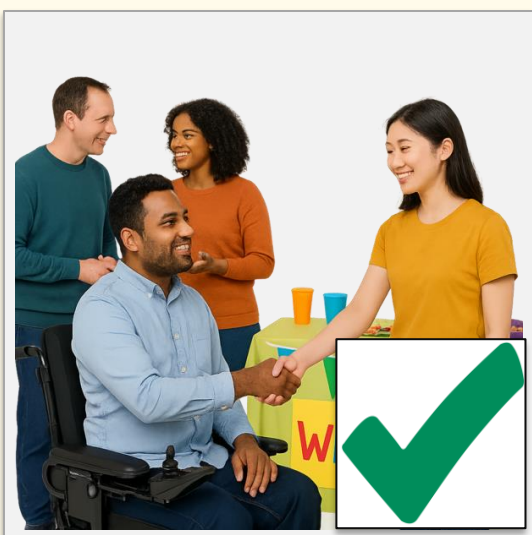

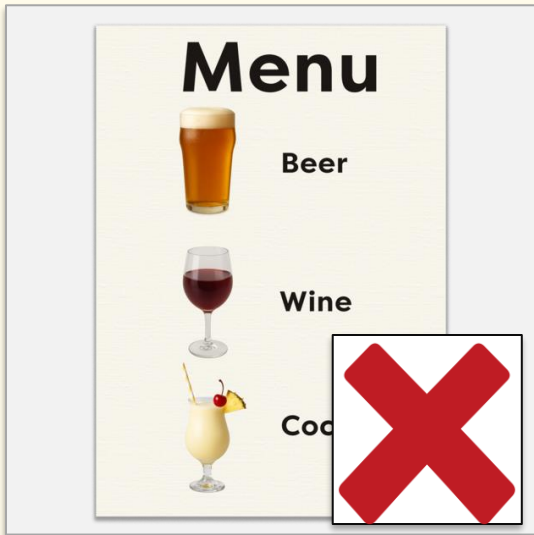

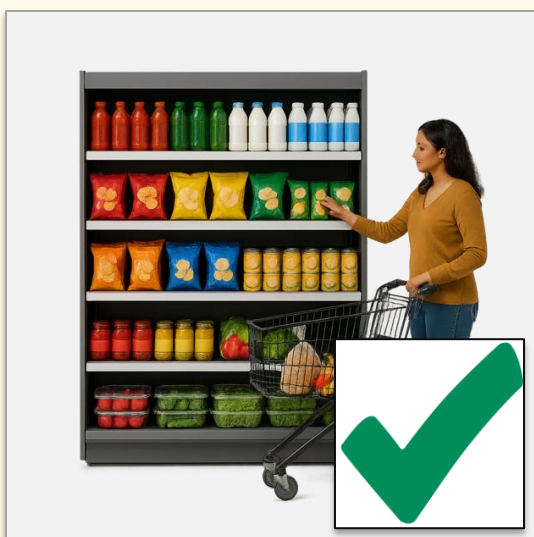




You are NOT allowed to have alcohol.

You can go in supermarkets.

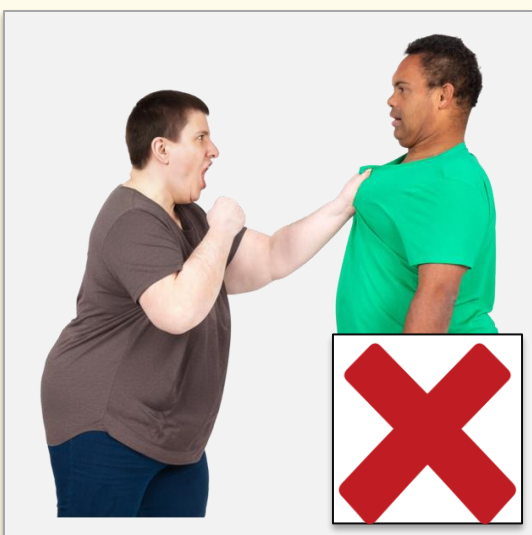


You are NOT allowed to take any drugs:
