The Ness County Board of Commissioners met for the Revenue Neutral Rate Hearing and Budget Hearing, Monday, September 8, 2024, at 8:45 a.m. in the Commissioner Chambers. Chairman Dave Albers called the meeting to order with Commissioner Mark Davis, Travis Petersilie, and County Clerk Lori Hertel, and interested public in attendance.

Revenue Neutral Hearing

Chairman Albers opened the Revenue Neutral Rate hearing at 8:45 a.m. Albers asked attending public for questions, comments, or concerns. No questions were presented. Commission reviewed the proposed RNR rate, with the conclusion that exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate was not needed to meet 2026 budget needs.

The RNR hearing was adjourned at 8:55 a.m.

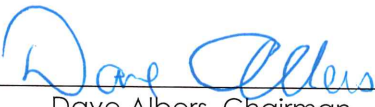
Budget Hearing

The 2026 Budget hearing was called to order at 8:55 a.m. The Board of Commissioners reviewed the proposed 2026 mill levy. Chairman Albers asked for public comments, questions or concerns on the proposed 2026 Budget. No questions were presented.

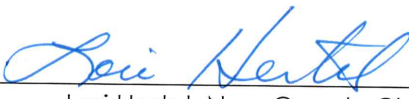
