September 14, 2026

The Ness County Board of Commissioners met in regular session Monday, September 14, 2026, at 9:00 a.m. in the Ness County Commissioner Chambers. Chairman Travis Petersilie called the meeting to order with Commissioners Mark Davis, Dave Albers, and Deputy County Clerk Makenzie Eck in attendance.

Road and Bridge

Ness County Road & Bridge/Landfill Supervisor Bryan Whipple met with the Commissioners. Whipple reported \$530.00 in landfill fees collected September 1-5, 2026.

Ness County EMS Director Kathy Clouston reported the donation that was received on the Dee Bauer Memorial Run.

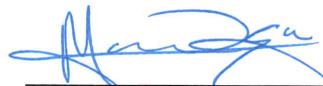
Ambulance repairs were discussed.
