

Saint Dominic Feast Day - August 8 Saint Dominic Guzman, the patron saint of our parish, was born into a time of great turmoil and confusion. Both within and outside of the Church there was great unrest, corruption and conflict. Dominic's mother, Blessed Juana de Aza, was pregnant with the future saint when she dreamt that she gave



birth to a dog carrying a flaming torch. This dog ran all over the earth, setting it ablaze. Dominic would go on to become a priest and found the Order of Preachers, the Dominicans, who are often referred to as the "Dogs of the Lord," who responded to the darkness of their time by preaching Jesus Christ and the beauty of the Catholic Faith. Saint Dominic is also traditionally associated with receiving the Rosary from Mary, which would serve to help people to come to know Jesus through the mediation on the mysteries of the Rosary, a literal catechism and bible study right in their pockets.

It is with great honor that we celebrate the Feast Day of St. Dominic in honor of former pastor, Monsignor William Augustine Crowe, who passed away on our patron saint's feast day, August 8, 2002, at the age of 83.



Born January 16, 1919, in Cashel, County Tipperary, Ireland, Monsignor took his vows after 19 years of study on April 27, 1947, at St. Peter, Wexford, Ireland. He was trained as a missionary and received his first appointment in the United States in November 1962, to the Holy Family Parish in Mobile, Alabama. From there, he served as Assistant Pastor of Christ the King Church, in Daphne, Alabama from September 1966 to November 1967, before moving to Florida to become the Administrator of St. Joseph Parish in Port St. Joe.

Monsignor Crowe served the St. Dominic Parish community for 32 years – from June 1070 to January 13, 2002, when he announced his retirement.

Monsignor gave a lifetime of ministry to the Church. During his years as pastor, he saw the Catholic Church outreach in Bay County grow extensively. Parish growth attributed to Msgr. Crowe includes: St. Dominic Church and church campus (church, rectory, grotto, parish hall, bookstore, education building office building, and multi-unit apartment building); Our Lady of Guadalupe Mission in Mexico Beach; Our Lady of Queen of Peace Mission in Fountain; Our Lady of the Rosary Parish in Bayou George; Sts. Peter and Paul Parish in Panama City; St. Francis of Assisi Parish in Blountstown, Barnabus House for Unwed Mothers in Panama City; and Catholic Charities buildings in Panama City. He also was instrumental in bringing the televised Mass to the Panhandle starting in 1983.

Monsignor William G. Crowe was an exemplary, devout, deeply committed and humble pastor and priest, who touched many lives. We owe much to Monsignor – he dedicated himself unselfishly to the temporal and spiritual well being of St. Dominic Parish, leading it boldly in the direction of growth, evangelization, and service.




