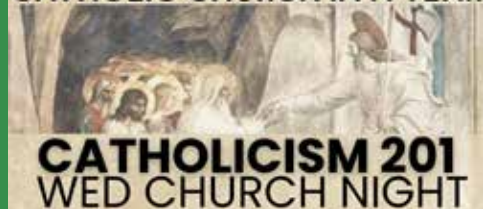

- To allow equal opportunity, families may be limited to a set number of intentions.

Catechetical Sunday in 2025 is celebrated today, Sunday, September 21, 2025, which is the third Sunday in September.

The theme for the day is "Always be ready to give an explanation...for a reason for your hope" (1 Peter 3), emphasizing the call to missionary discipleship and the duty of all Catholics to witness to their faith with gentleness and respect.

This day is dedicated to recognizing and commissioning catechists, including parents and guardians who are considered the first and primary teachers of the faith, as well as other individuals who volunteer their time and talents in faith formation.

PERPETUAL ADORATION is a Eucharistic devotion whereby we unite in taking hours of adoration before the Most Blessed Sacrament both during the day and throughout the night, seven days a week. 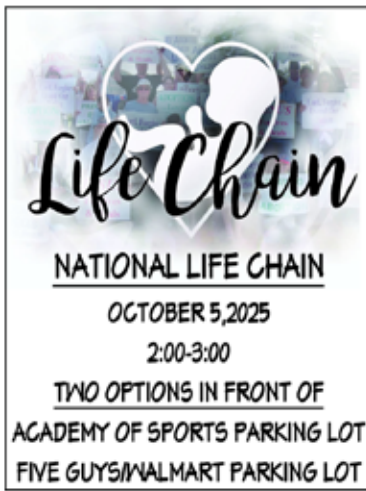
