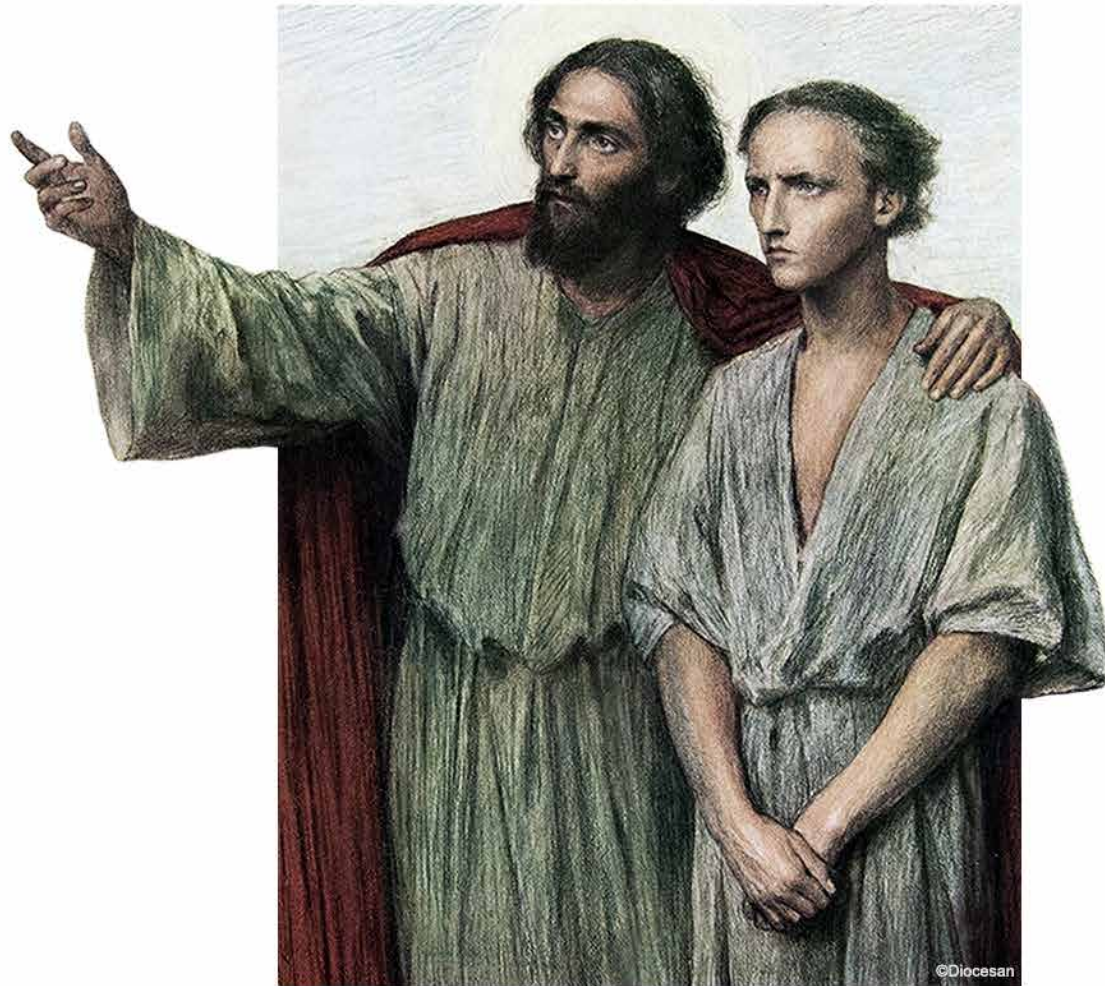

"Missionaries of Hope Among all Peoples"

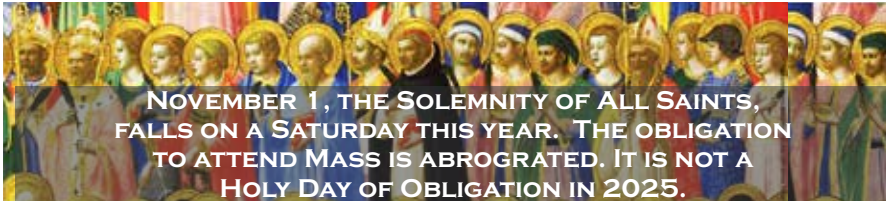
