


PRIESTLY PRAYER

THE SOCIETY OF ST. VINCENT DE PAUL, ST. DOMINIC CONFERENCE, is dedicated to serving those in need in our



community. We are committed to providing practical assistance, advocacy, and companionship to individuals and families facing hardship. Our mission centers on alleviating poverty and promoting dignity, regardless of religious affiliation, through direct aid such as food, clothing, housing support, and financial assistance.

During the last fiscal year we fed 1,200 meals at the St. Andrews Community Dinners and provided housing and utilities assistance totaling \$19,320. We assisted with baby needs, food for families, car repairs, medical expenses, personal hygiene kits, and many other expenses. Every recipient is fully vetted, and aid is paid directly to landlords,

utility companies, etc. Along with helping the community at large, we also organized several projects to help our parishioners and their families: 100 back-to-school backpacks, 65 complete meals for Thanksgiving, 30 complete Easter meals, and 100 Christmas angels for nursing home residents.

Our sole source of revenue is from our church members. We spend whatever funds we receive and do not carry a large bank balance. We receive an average of 30 calls per week asking for assistance. While we cannot help everyone, we strive to spend our funds wisely and help as many people as possible.


