

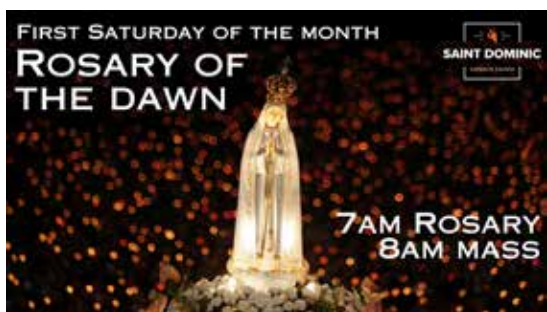
Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,
