**THE MOST HOLY TRINITY  
 LIFE, THE UNIVERSE, AND EVERYTHING**

Why does God love us so much? And why are we able to love others? The answer to these questions is found in the meaning of today's feast. Trinity Sunday celebrates not so much an idea of three-in-one, as the relationship of the Persons of the Trinity with each other and with us. The idea of the Trinity is based on love. But God's love was so great, God went even further. God created us to be loved by God.

Though human love is not perfect, the love of man and woman can produce another person, a child. The three Persons of the Trinity share one life in God. But through baptism we also share in God's life. Just as parents love to see how their children look like them, so God loves to see the divine in us.

Our decision to love is a response to God's love, and our ability to love is itself a gift from God. The meaning of life, the universe, and everything is Love, the love of the Trinity for each other and for us. The question now is, how well do we use that gift of God's love by loving each other?

**THE MONTH OF JUNE IS DEDICATED TO THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS.**

Understood in the light of the Scriptures, the term "Sacred Heart of Jesus" denotes the entire mystery of Christ, the totality of his being, and his person considered in its most intimate essential: Son of God, uncreated wisdom; infinite charity, principal of the salvation and sanctification of mankind. The "Sacred Heart" is Christ, the Word Incarnate, Saviour, intrinsically containing, in the Spirit, an infinite divine-human love for the Father and for his brothers. Devotion to the Sacred Heart is a wonderful historical expression of the Church's piety for Christ, her Spouse and Lord: it calls for a fundamental attitude of conversion and reparation, of love and gratitude, apostolic commitment and dedication to Christ and his saving work.

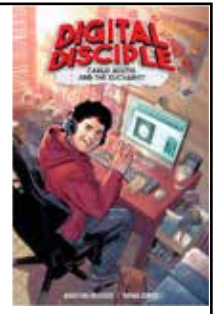
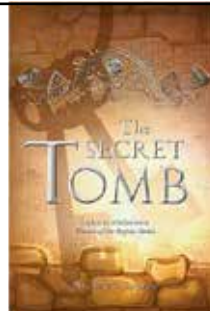

**JUNIO: MES DEL SAGRADO CORAZÓN DE JESÚS**

Adoramos el Corazón de Cristo porque es el corazón del Verbo encarnado, del Hijo de Dios hecho hombre.



La imagen del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús nos recuerda el núcleo central de nuestra fe: todo lo que Dios nos ama con su Corazón y todo lo que nosotros, por tanto, le debemos amar. Jesús tiene un Corazón que ama sin medida. Y tanto nos ama, que sufre cuando su inmenso amor no es correspondido.

La Iglesia dedica todo el mes de junio al Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, con la finalidad de que los católicos lo veneremos, lo honremos y lo imitemos especialmente en estos 30 días.

Esto significa que debemos vivir este mes demostrándole a Jesús con nuestras obras que lo amamos, que correspondemos al gran amor que Él nos tiene y que nos ha demostrado entregándose a la muerte por nosotros, quedándose en la

Eucaristía y enseñándonos el camino a la vida eterna. Todos los días podemos acercarnos a Jesús o alejarnos de Él. De nosotros depende, ya que Él siempre nos está esperando y amando.

Debemos vivir recordándolo y pensar cada vez que actuamos: ¿Qué haría Jesús en esta situación, qué le dictaría su Corazón? Y eso es lo que debemos hacer (ante un problema en la familia, en el trabajo, en nuestra comunidad, con nuestras amistades, etc.).

Debemos, por tanto, pensar si las obras o acciones que vamos a hacer nos alejan o acercan a Dios. Tener en casa o en el trabajo una imagen del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús, nos ayuda a recordar su gran amor y a imitarlo en este mes de junio y durante todo el año.

## CAMINO DEL DISCIPULADO: ENCUENTRO, FORMAR, EVANGELIZAR

### LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD LA VIDA, EL UNIVERSO Y TODO LO DEMÁS

¿Por qué Dios nos ama tanto? ¿Y por qué somos capaces de amar a los demás? La respuesta a estas preguntas se encuentra en el significado de la fiesta de hoy. La Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad no celebra tanto la idea de tres en uno sino la relación de las Personas de la Trinidad entre sí y con nosotros.

La idea es que el Padre se expresó como la Palabra. Como era una expresión perfecta, el Verbo es su Hijo e igual al Padre. El amor del Padre y del Hijo se expresa como el Espíritu Santo. Siendo un amor perfecto, él también es igual al Padre y al Hijo. Entonces, incluso la idea de la Trinidad tiene su fundamento en el amor. Pero el amor de Dios fue tan grande que quiso tomarlo aún más allá. Dios nos creó para ser amados por Dios.

En la segunda lectura, Pablo bendice a los corintios con el “amor de Dios y la comunión del Espíritu Santo”. El libro de Génesis (3,18) dice que no es bueno que el hombre esté solo. Por eso Dios creó a la mujer, y por medio del hombre y la mujer a toda la humanidad, para poder amarse unos a otros. Aunque el amor humano no es perfecto, el amor entre el hombre y la mujer puede producir a otra persona, a un bebé. Las tres Personas de la Trinidad comparten una sola vida en Dios. Pero a través del bautismo, también compartimos la vida de Dios. Así como a los padres les encanta ver cómo sus hijos se parecen a ellos, a Dios le encanta ver lo divino en nosotros.

La primera lectura nos recuerda de la cercanía que Dios tiene para con la humanidad. Moisés puede hablar con Dios y Dios responde concediendo lo que ha pedido. El Evangelio cuenta cuánto ama Dios al mundo, que el mismo Hijo de Dios fue enviado a morir por nosotros. Pero a veces nos olvidamos que el amor de Dios es lo primordial. Pensamos que cuanto más amorosos seamos, Dios nos va amar más, pero el amor viene de Dios (1 Juan 4,7–11), así que cuando amamos a alguien no hace que Dios nos ame más; amamos porque Dios nos ama primero. Nuestra decisión de amar es una respuesta al amor de Dios, y nuestra capacidad de amar es en sí misma un regalo de Dios. El sentido de la vida, del universo y de todo es el Amor, el amor de la Trinidad por los demás y por nosotros. La pregunta ahora es, ¿cómo utilizamos ese regalo del amor de Dios para amarnos unos a otros?
