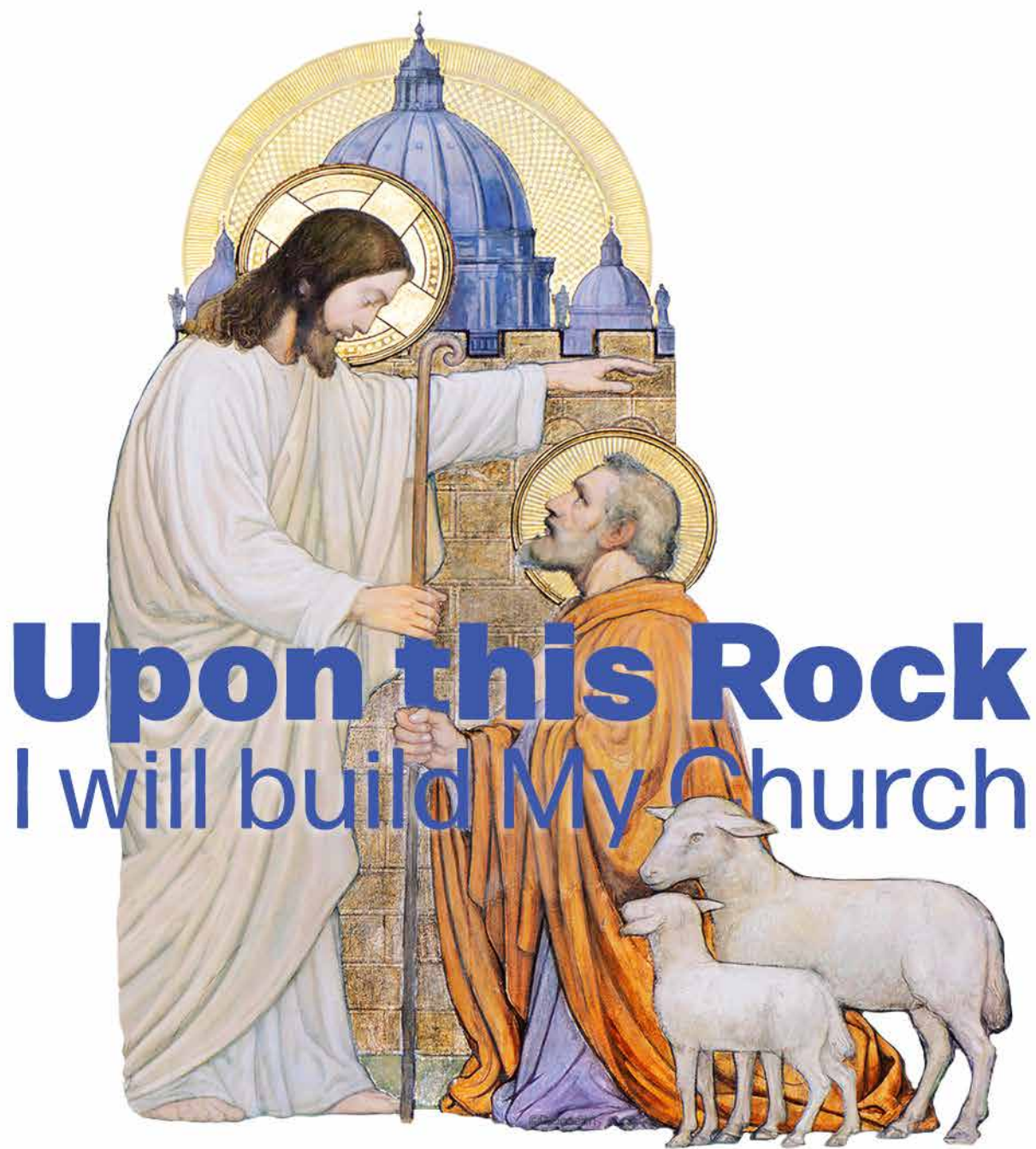

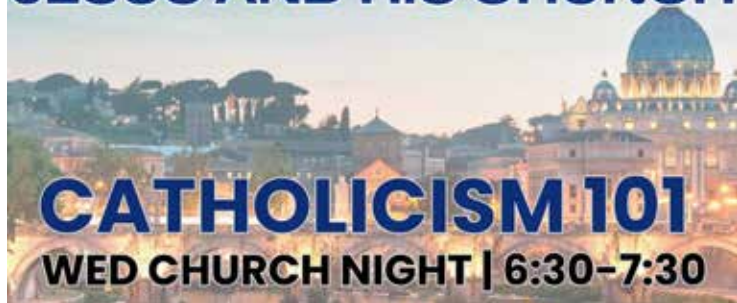

THE DEVOTION FOR AUGUST IS THE IMMACULATE HEART OF MARY

It's Major Feast: Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary (August 15);
Feast of the Queenship of Mary (August 22)

The heart of Mary is full of love for God, and, because she is sinless, hers is the only human heart capable of loving God the way we were meant to. The image of the Immaculate Heart recognizes Mary's extraordinary holiness and the great love she has for her son that we are called to imitate. How to celebrate: Keep the Immaculate Heart close to you by wearing the Miraculous Medal, which has an image of Our Lady's Heart on the back.



PERPETUAL ADORATION is a Eucharistic devotion whereby we unite in taking hours of adoration before the Most Blessed Sacrament both during the day and throughout the night, seven days a week. This is a great way to spend some time one-on-one with the Lord, encountering the Lord of all the universe who humbles himself and appears to us in our midst.
