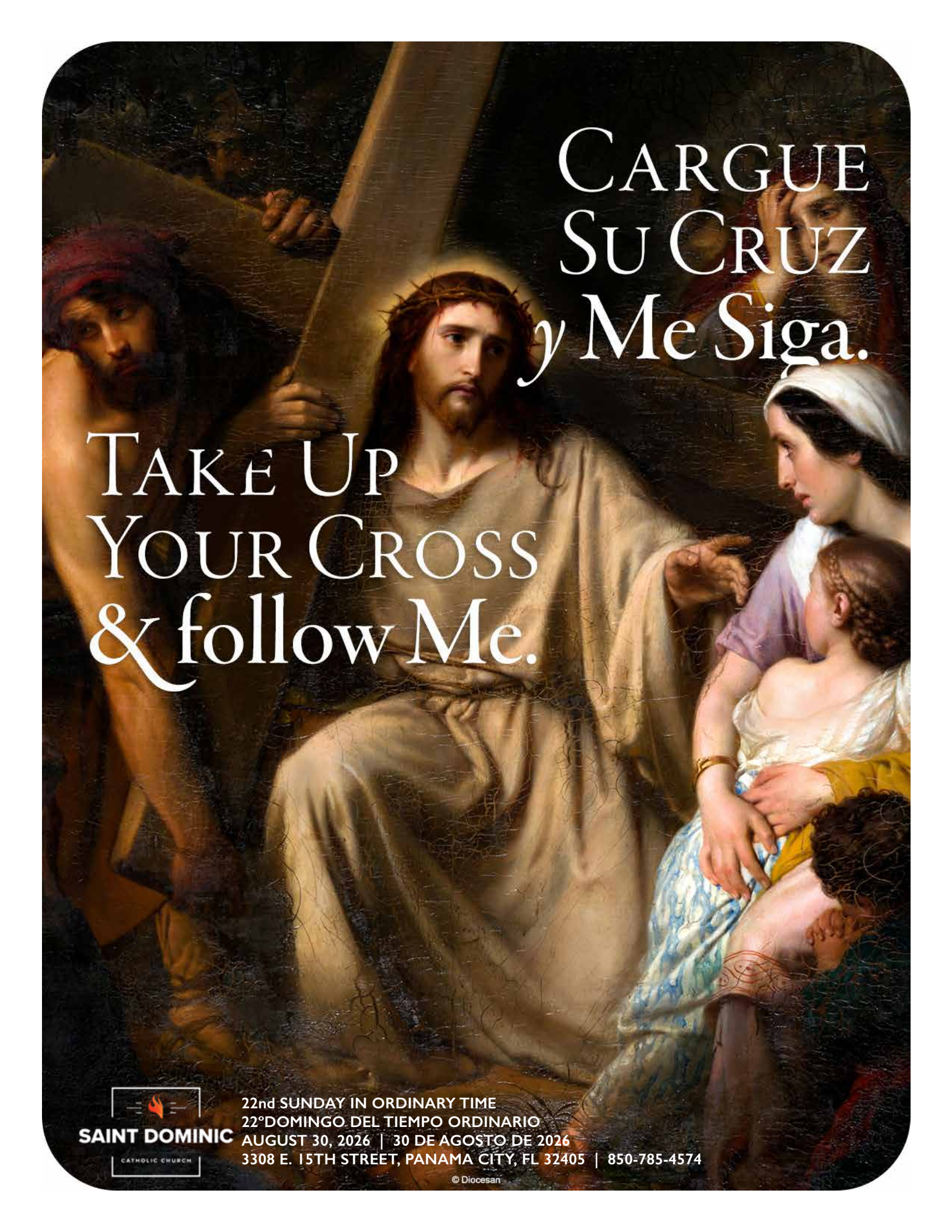

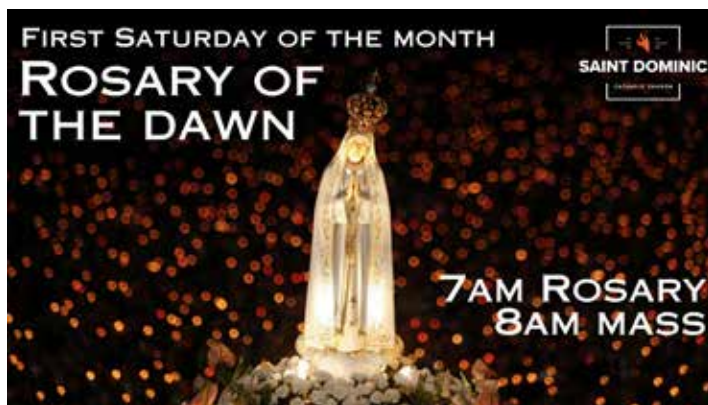
### Do you or a loved one need the healing prayers of others?
