THE GREAT STORY OF SALVATION AND THE RESCUE MISSION OF CHRIST

One of my favorite scenes in all of the Bible, which we have depicted on our ambo and altar in the Church in mosaic form, is the Road to Emmaus. During this event, Jesus walks with two disciples on the journey and unpacks the whole story of salvation history to them. They are hurting and discouraged, and as they walk their hearts start burning with excitement and understanding. This story culminates in Jesus “breaking the bread” with them, at which time their eyes are opened and they recognize Him. That is the journey we are undertaking from now

till December here at Saint Dominic. During the Sunday homilies we will journey through all of salvation history: starting with Creation all the way through the Old Testament, the life and ministry of Jesus, and our own call to mission as the Church. As Jesus “unpacks the Scriptures for us,” we will come to know the Great Story of salvation and our own stories as well. This journey will help us to understand the beauty and truth of our faith and the awesome privilege we have to be members of the Catholic Church. I am so excited to be on this journey with you and I hope that it bears abundant fruit for our whole Parish. SEPTEMBER IS TRADITIONALLY DEDICATED TO THE SEVEN SORROWS (OR DOLOURS) OF MARY; FEAST DAY - SEPTEMBER 15TH



Devotion to Our Lady of Sorrows became a standard devotion in the Church around the 14th century. It was revealed to St. Bridget of Sweden (1303–1373) that devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary’s Seven Sorrows would bring great signal graces. The devotion consists in praying seven Hail Marys while meditating on the Seven Sorrows of Mary: 1)The Prophecy of Simeon (Luke 2:34-35); 2)The Flight into Egypt (Matthew 2:13-21); 3)The Loss of Jesus for Three Days (Luke 2:41-50); 4)The Carrying of the Cross (John 19:17); 5)The Crucifixion of Jesus (John 19:18-30); 6)Jesus Taken Down from the Cross (John 19:39-40); 7)Jesus Laid in the Tomb (John 19:39-42).

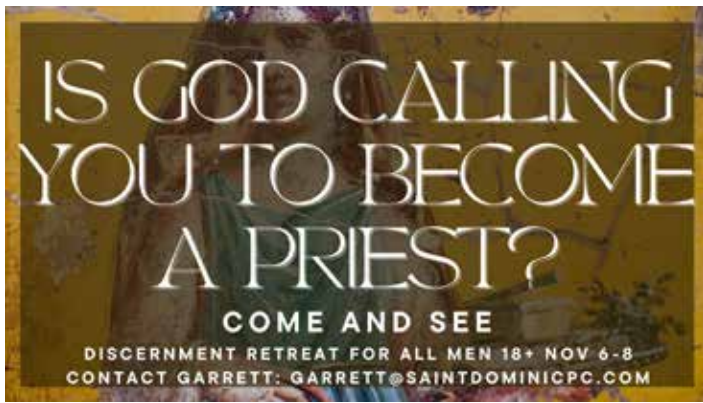
