

Young Kids Family Camp Confirmation & Instructions

Dear Family,

We have received your registration for Young Kids Family Camp at Hope Shores. Here are a few things you will need to know in preparation for a great weekend together.

- Your \$100 Deposit is non-refundable unless we can fill your spot. The balance is <u>due 1 week</u>
 <u>before the start date of the Young Kids Family Camp</u>. To pay your balance, go to the <u>Hope</u>
 <u>Shores website</u> and click on REGISTRATION. Then login to your account and pay the remaining balance.
- 2. Directions are at the end of this letter to help you find Hope Shores. It's easy to follow and it takes about 2 hours to get there from the Twin Cities.
- 3. Please plan to arrive on Thursday afternoon between 3:00 and 4:00 p.m., so you don't miss any of the excitement. Our awesome staff will be ready and waiting by the Canteen building (the first white building you will pass as you enter the Hope Shores gravel driveway) to help you get checked in, find your cabin, and unload your vehicle. If you arrive after 4:00 pm, check in at the Lodge to receive information for the weekend. Please only park your vehicle in the designated area (along the driveway entrance to camp, away from where any camp activities will be occurring).
- 4. For cabin sleeping arrangements, <u>you must bring a Twin-sized fitted sheet to cover each bunk</u> (state law) and a sleeping bag/blankets and pillow with pillowcase for each person in your <u>group</u>. If you have children too small for a bunk, please bring a pack-n-play for them.
- 5. What to bring to camp: Bible, clothes for indoor and outdoor activities (warm & cool weather), swimsuit, towels, washcloth, toiletries, lawn chairs, a flashlight or head lamp, etc.

This year we'll have a "Country/Western" theme for our Banquet Night on Thursday evening. Come with an outfit that fits this theme! Make it your own and be creative.

Other equipment you may wish to bring: money for camp store (souvenirs, camp shirts, sweatshirts, and hats), bug spray, sunscreen, lawn games, a favorite board game, and a white t-shirt for tie-dye.

Please note: Canteen (pop, candy, snacks) is included in the registration fee.

- 8. Come prepared for our annual talent show that will take place on the final night of your stay at Hope Shores. We love to highlight the young talents of kids! Adults are welcome to be a part of this great night, especially if it helps your kids!
- 9. When you arrive, if you need a space to store breastmilk, please notify the Camp Director, Greta Schutte, and she will show you where this will be refrigerated for you. Please label your breastmilk so it can be easily identified. You should plan to connect with a Hope Shores staff member when you need someone to get your breastmilk for use. The lodge kitchen is a staff only space.
- 10. Please bring 2 dozen of your favorite treats/snacks to share. Put your name on your container if you want it back.
- 11. There is only limited fishing equipment, so bring your own if you plan to fish. You will need a fishing license, so if you plan to fish, please purchase one before you come. Children under 16 do not need a Minnesota fishing license.
- 12. Please leave your pets with a friend or in a kennel. Sorry, but Hope Shores has no accommodation for these loved ones.
- 13. The check-out time on Saturday is between 1:00-2:00 p.m.
