| 11:30 a.m. – 1:00 p.m.  | <p><b>Colorectal Cancer Screening at 45: Implementation, Access, and System Readiness</b></p> <p>As rates of early age onset colorectal cancer continue to rise, screening policies across Canada are evolving in response to changing epidemiology and growing evidence supporting earlier detection. Following Prince Edward Island's decision in March 2026 to become the first province to lower the screening age for average-risk colorectal cancer, Ontario lowered the age of eligibility from 50 to 45 in July 2026 and introduced several updates to its <a href="#">ColonCancerCheck program</a>, marking another important milestone in the evolution of colorectal cancer early detection.</p> <p>While policy change represents significant progress, its impact will depend on effective implementation, system readiness, public awareness, equitable participation, and sufficient capacity to meet increased demand. | 1:45 p.m. – 2:45 p.m. | <p><b>Training the Front-Line Primary Care Professionals: Embedding Early Age Onset Cancer Education Across Medical and Nursing Pathways</b></p> <p>As rates of early age onset cancer (EAOC) continue to rise, primary care providers are increasingly encountering cancers in populations historically considered low risk. Yet educational curricula, clinical training pathways, and professional development programs have not consistently evolved at the same pace as the changing epidemiology of cancer in younger adults. Delayed recognition can contribute to delays in diagnosis and missed opportunities for earlier intervention.</p> <p>This session will examine opportunities to strengthen medical and nursing education to better equip healthcare professionals with the knowledge and tools needed to recognize and appropriately investigate potential signs and symptoms of cancer in younger adults. A deeper understanding of tumour biology is transforming cancer diagnosis and treatment, enabling more personalized care based on the unique molecular characteristics of an individual's tumour. Advances in biomarker testing, genomic profiling, and precision oncology are helping identify targeted therapies, immunotherapies, clinical trial opportunities, and, in some cases, off-label treatment options.</p> <p>As precision oncology continues to evolve, understanding when advanced tumour testing may be appropriate and how these results can inform treatment decisions is becoming increasingly important. Beyond clinical decisions, patients are often navigating uncertainty, fragmented communication, psychosocial and emotional challenges, and complex healthcare systems while simultaneously managing careers, young families, financial responsibilities, social pressures, and evolving identities.</p> <p>This patient panel will examine the cancer journey through the lived experiences of younger adults, exploring where traditional models of care align with patient needs and where they do not. Rather than focusing solely on gaps in care, the discussion will consider what patients value most: the conversations that build trust, the supports that foster resilience, and the care experiences that help younger patients feel seen as individuals, not simply by their diagnosis. | 3:45 p.m. – 4:45 p.m. | <p><b>Cancer Care Delivery Through Subcutaneous Treatment</b></p> <p>How cancer treatment is delivered can have a significant impact on both the patient experience and the capacity of healthcare systems to provide timely care. Subcutaneous formulations are changing how certain cancer treatments, including immunotherapies, can be administered, offering an alternative to traditional intravenous delivery. With substantially shorter administration times, subcutaneous treatment can reduce the time patients spend receiving therapy in cancer centres.</p> <p>This session will examine the role of subcutaneous treatment in cancer care delivery, consider how the shift from intravenous to subcutaneous administration may influence the patient experience and how care is delivered across cancer systems. For younger adults, reducing the time and burden associated with treatment may provide greater flexibility in balancing cancer care with work, family, and life beyond treatment. The discussion will also consider the potential for subcutaneous treatment to support healthcare system capacity and more flexible models of care, alongside the clinical and system-level considerations that will shape its integration into cancer care.</p> |
