- Enterprise Development & Resource Mobilization Skills: Tools to design social enterprises, secure funding, and ensure long-term sustainability.
- Strategic & Financial Planning Competence: Proficiency in using the Business Model Canvas and creating integrated strategies for cohesive organizational impact.
- Cross-Sector Leadership & Implementation Capacity: Skills to leverage the Humanitarian-Development-Peace nexus and develop actionable, systemic plans for growth.

Participants will engage in facilitated discussions, practical exercises, and real-world case reflections, with ample opportunities for peer exchange. 
