## JOIN OUR ELDERS CIRCLE

What is the Elders Circle?

The Elders Circle will guide and mentor our community's young leaders through seasonal land-based activities, cultural teachings, and shared learning. Elders will help shape how knowledge, traditions, and stewardship practices are passed down to the next generations.

As an Elder Circle member you:

- Share your knowledge and experiences with youth 16+ by participating in gatherings and seasonal on the land activities
- Attend 4 gatherings between September 2025 – March 2026
- Provide guidance for and participate in seasonal on-the-land activities, including Fish Camp, Muskrat Camp, the Indigenous Knowledge and Science Forum and more.
- Help plan programming that will connect Grade 8 students with Youth mentors starting in Year 2.

## JOIN OUR YOUTH CIRCLE

What is the Youth Circle?

The Youth Circle will work alongside Elders to learn and refine land-based skills, leadership skills and increase your knowledge of environmental stewardship — as well as helping build a mentorship program that will connect you with younger students in the community starting next year, giving you the opportunity to become a mentor.

As a Youth Circle member you:

- Join seasonal on-the-land activities, including Fish Camp, Muskrat Camp, the Indigenous Knowledge and Science Forum and other fall, winter and spring activities.
- Learn from Elders about leadership, Indigenous governance, and environmental stewardship.
- Participate in 4 gatherings between September 2025 – March 2026.
- Work with Elders to design a mentorship program for Grade 8 students in Fort Chipewyan.
