JUBILEE

THE NATIONAL JUBILEE PILGRIMAGE OF HOPE, Saturday 13 - Sunday 14 September 2025

The Pilgrimage of Hope is a national walking pilgrimage for England & Wales with four main Ways converging at the Cathedral of St Barnabas, Nottingham, on **Saturday 13 September**, the eve of the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. It is an initiative of the *Hearts in Search of God* project which promotes and develops walking pilgrimage in our nations.

The Ways start at the Catholic cathedrals in Cardiff, Leeds, Norwich and St George's Cathedral, Southwark, London, and will bless our nations with a Sign of the Cross. The routes use established hiking routes and are off road as much as possible. A small group of 'perpetual pilgrims' will walk the full distance of each Way, with up to 20-day pilgrims joining for day stages. There are potential feeder routes to the four main Ways from all the other Catholic cathedrals of England & Wales. Shorter walks have been planned for many stages.

The Main Ways pass through the following dioceses, calling at the Catholic and other churches along the Way.

- o St Matthew's Way: Cardiff-Menevia, Birmingham & Nottingham, starts 28 Aug
- o St Mark's Way: Leeds, Hallam & Nottingham, starts 6 Sept
- St Luke's Way: East Anglia & Nottingham, starts 4 Sept
- o St John's Way: Southwark, Westminster, Northampton & Nottingham, starts 1 Sept

The Pilgrimage will embody the values of the Sisters of the Holy Cross of compassion, faith, prayer and community. <u>Pilgrimage Walk | The Pilgrimage of Hope</u> – registration is now open for Day Pilgrims **but will close on 21 August!**
