### **Welcome back**

You may have seen on the news this week that Pope XIV closed the Holy Door of St Peter's Basilica in Rome on the Solemnity of the Epiphany of the Lord. This marked the official end of the Jubilee Year of Hope, which was called by Pope Francis, and concluded by Pope Leo. It has been an enriching experience for so many. It is estimated that over 33 million people visited Rome for the Jubilee Year, and a highlight for me was accompanying the group of our headteachers on pilgrimage in September.

When a Jubilee Year ended in the Bible, life would go back to normal. Yet people held onto the hope of the coming Messiah, who was prophesised to declare not just a Jubilee Year but a Jubilee eternity. Our Jubilee Year has reminded us that we are Jubilee people. We have experienced a renewal of 'hope' – despite the uncertainties and fears that exist in our world. The good news of the Jubilee Year, and for us as pilgrims of hope, is that God is with us in all the challenges we face. We are empowered and animated by hope to strive for a more just world through acts of charity, mercy and care for creation in our homes and schools.

It has been a real privilege for us in the Education Department to see the work that has taken place in our schools and colleges to mark this special year and we are hugely grateful for all your efforts.  
Thank you for all that you have done over the past year.

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### **Insurance Arrangements Buildings**

It has been brought to our attention that some schools have been contacted by Zurich offering insurance cover directly or through the local authority. We have advised that all schools (other than Sefton schools who have a separate arrangement) should continue with RPA until further notice. This cover will renew automatically in April this year. We are working with the Catholic Insurance Service to secure the best services for schools and will update you in due course if our advice changes.
