We would appreciate it if Catechumens and Candidates could arrive no later than **2.40pm** to ensure there is enough time to register their attendance. The details you provide the online form will be shared with the Dean of the area of which you have applied, your local parish, and the Diocesan administration team. It may be shared with other parties associated with Diocesan sacramental preparation and relevant and appropriate Diocesan bodies and authorities.

Your local parish will be in touch after registration period ends on the **13 February** (you will not be contacted beforehand) with details about meetings in your local area. You will likely be contacted after Easter. **Please do not worry if you are not contacted immediately.** If you have any queries, please contact your parish priest.

The information you provide will be held for the sacramental year (which ends on the day new application forms go online for the succeeding sacramental preparation year) and your contact information may be used to contact you by email, text, letter or phone.
