Searles Horticultural Mix-Ins Coir Peat is a natural, renewable growing medium made from coconut husk fibres, ideal for improving moisture retention and aeration in potting mixes.

When blended with potting mixes, Coir Peat helps hold water while still allowing air movement around plant roots. Lightweight and free draining, it supports healthy root development.

Searles Horticultural Mix-Ins Coir Peat is ideal for indoor plants, propagation, seed raising and general potting mixes where consistent moisture is important.

HOW TO USE

FOR INDOOR PLANTS & POTTING MIXES

Improves moisture retention while keeping mixes light and open.

1. Lightly moisten Coir Peat before use.
2. Mix 1 part Coir Peat with 4 parts potting mix.
3. Blend evenly, plant as required and water gently.



FOR SEED RAISING

Helps maintain consistent moisture during germination.

1. Mix 1 part Coir Peat with 3 parts seed raising mix.
2. Sow seeds as directed and keep evenly moist.

FOR WORM FARMING

Add a small layer of Coir Peat to the base of the worm farm.
