Foreword

MORE THAN COLOUR

Good design begins where material, function and form come together naturally.

At zai, material always comes first. Its properties determine construction and skiing characteristics: wood stores energy. Titanal provides stability. Rubber creates smoothness. And stone dampens vibrations in a way no synthetic material can match. New materials are also introduced whenever they can meet a challenge better than the existing solution.

For the 2026/27 collection, proven models have been structurally revised, while new variants expand the range.

zai is also expanding its colour palette with Navy Blue, Beige and White. Three colours that fit naturally into the collection because they do not distract from the product, but underline it.

DISRUPTOR

The Disruptor is designed to do as much as possible without demanding attention.

It is aimed at skiers who value precision, while also looking for a ski that remains calm and predictable even after many hours on the piste.

Its foundation is a sandwich construction of rubber, Paulownia and beech wood, and Titanal.

Each material has a clearly defined role. Rubber provides smoothness, the wood core elasticity and Titanal stability, even on hard pistes.

The Disruptor's characteristics vary with its length: the shorter models (145, 151 and 158 cm) are quick to turn and smooth. At 164 cm and 170 cm, a

firmness develops in the core that makes the ski agile and grippy. The longest versions (176 and 181 cm) are designed for skiers who expect direct feedback even at high speed.

The Disruptor is now available not only in Black, but also in White. White does not change the character of the ski. The colour emphasises its clean lines and reduced design.

The Disruptor is delivered with the Superflex binding plate and the zai by Tyrolia PRD12 Grip Walk binding system. A two-year warranty and insurance are included and are activated through specialist retailers or in the zai Experience Club.

SUMMIT

The Summit is an all-mountain ski for every type of terrain and snow. It handles variable terrain, powder and firn, tight couloirs and steep faces.

Its construction combines stability with float. The rubber surface reduces vibrations and ensures a calm ride even at higher speeds. With its light tip rocker, the Summit is easy to turn.

The new Summit PRO expands the range. Its wider sidecut provides ad-

ditional float in deep snow and extends its range of use where softer snow changes the demands placed on a ski.

Summit and Summit PRO are available in Black and are delivered with the Superflex binding plate and the zai by Tyrolia PRD12 Grip Walk binding system. A two-year warranty and insurance are included in the package and are activated through specialist retailers or in the zai Experience Club.

TITAN

The Titan stands for dynamics and precision. Titanal gives the Titan its name – and determines its properties. The metallic shimmering top sheet provides stability, torsional stiffness and reliable edge grip. Inside, a wood core of Paulownia and beech combines lightness with dynamics.

The short to medium turn radius enables quick changes of direction and precise handling – even on demanding pistes and at high speed. Its look is inspired by the structure of glacial ice. The metallic surface empha-

hasises the ski's sporty character while also referencing the material that gives it its name.

The zai Titan is delivered with the Superflex binding plate and the zai by Tyrolia PRD12 Grip Walk binding system. For performance-oriented skiers, it is also optionally available with the EVO race plate and Tyrolia ST14 Freeflex binding. A two-year warranty and insurance are included and are activated through specialist retailers or in the zai Experience Club.

SMOKED OAK

The zai Wood is a tribute to wood. Smoked oak gives it its warm character. The natural grain makes every surface unique. Over the years, a patina develops that gives each ski a character of its own.

Beneath the wooden surface, a construction of pre-tensioned wood core, steel and Titanal provides easy handling, high stability and control in a wide range of snow conditions. Wood and steel are materials that age. At the same time, they are easy to

maintain and restore. This means the beauty and quality of the zai Wood can be preserved for years.

The zai Wood is delivered with the Superflex binding plate and the zai by Tyrolia PRD12 Grip Walk binding system. It is also available on request with a light ash surface. The package includes zai carbon poles, a zai ski bag, as well as a two-year warranty and insurance. These are activated through specialist retailers or in the zai Experience Club.

BLADE II

Some developments begin with a simple question: can a material that has been the benchmark for years be replaced? For the zai Blade, the answer was yes.

Carbon is replaced by cellulose. A material whose potential zai uses in a new construction. Together with Titanal and a pre-tensioned bamboo core, it creates a ski that combines dampening, directness and dynamics in a new way, because each material is used where its strengths can be fully exploited. The geometry has also been developed further. The tapered tip guides

the ski precisely into the fall line, while the sidecut supports a smooth turn build-up. The result is a ski that responds directly without ever feeling nervous – developed for hard pistes and performance-oriented skiers.

The Blade is available in two lengths and is delivered with the Superflex binding plate and the zai by Tyrolia PRD12 Grip Walk binding system. The package also includes zai carbon poles, a zai ski bag, as well as a two-year warranty and insurance. These are activated through specialist retailers or in the zai Experience Club.



STONE COLLECTION

Some ideas seem impossible at first. Building a ski with stone was one of them.

When zai presented the first ski with a stone core in 2007, there was no precedent to follow. To this day, the Stone Collection, with its stone topsheet, remains unique in the world.

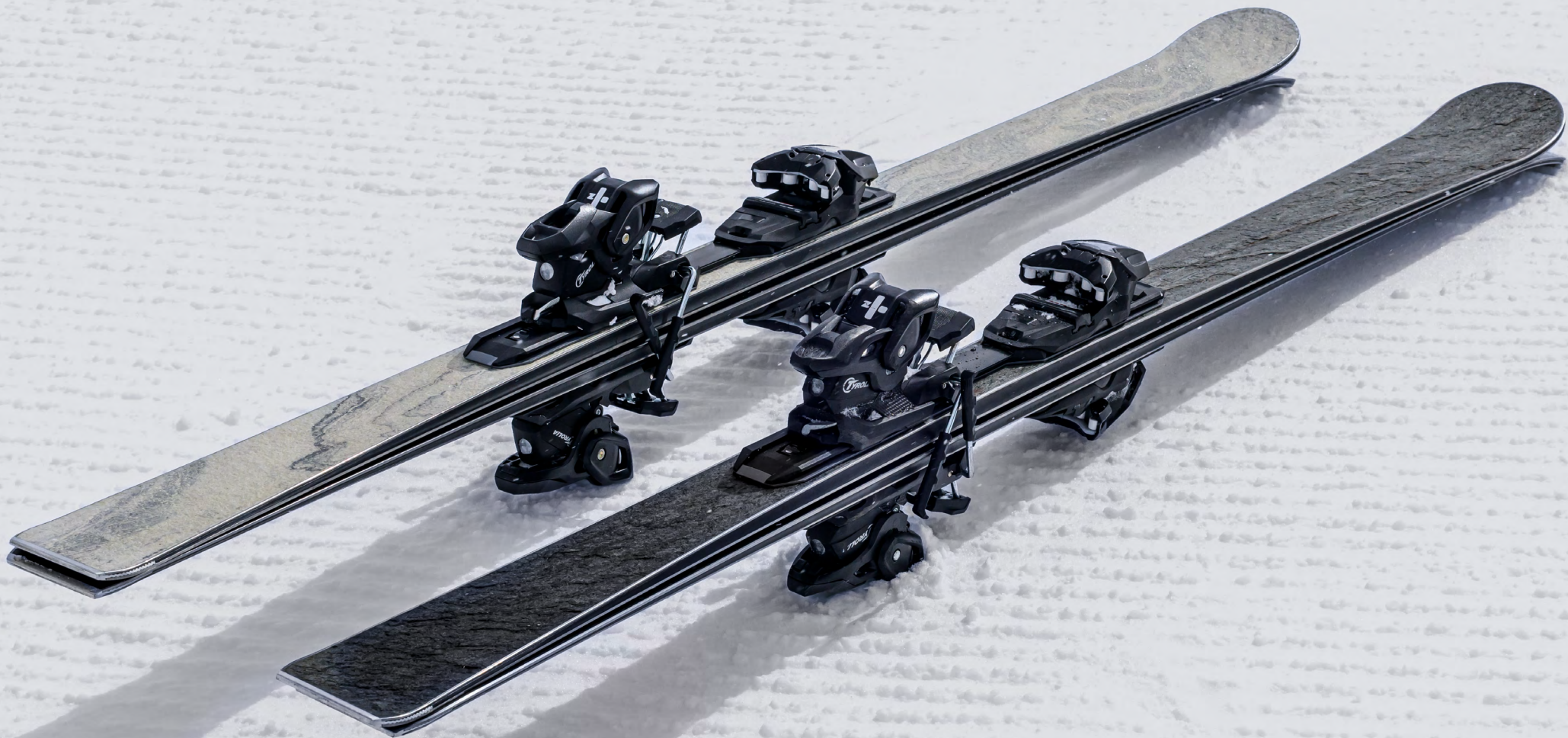
Today, it has become part of the identity of the brand.

Stone possesses properties that are difficult to achieve with other materials. It dampens vibrations, ensures exceptional smoothness and gives the ski a level of precision that is particularly noticeable on hard pistes. At the

same time, the natural structure makes every ski unique.

With slate, black marble and white marble, the Stone Collection comprises three distinctive variants. They differ in their surface, but follow the same conviction: materials are not selected according to convention, but according to their properties.

Every ski in the Stone Collection comes equipped with the zai by Tyrolia binding system. The package also includes zai carbon poles, a zai ski bag, as well as two years of warranty and insurance. These are activated through your specialist retailer or in the zai Experience Club.

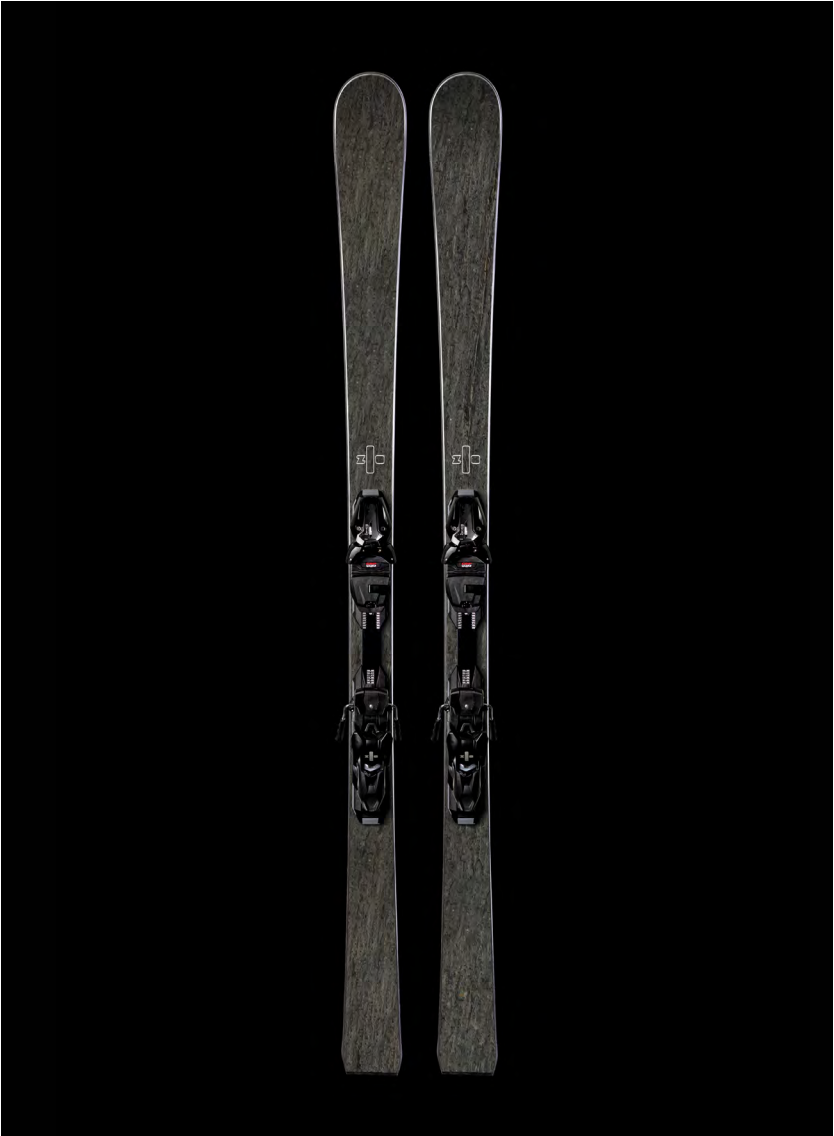
SLATE

Slate has shaped the Alpine landscape for centuries. zai gives this natural stone a new form – and a new purpose.

As a top sheet, slate combines high compressive strength with a dampening effect. The ski remains calm on the snow and tracks precisely through the turn – especially on hard pistes. The surface is understated. Its beauty comes from the stone itself – every ski is unique. This year, a new slate is

used, with a subtly different appearance: slightly darker and less green. The skiing characteristics remain unchanged.

The zai Stone Slate is delivered with the Superflex binding plate and the zai by Tyrolia PRD12 Grip Walk binding system. The package includes zai carbon poles, a zai ski bag, as well as a two-year warranty and insurance. These are activated through specialist retailers or in the zai Experience Club.

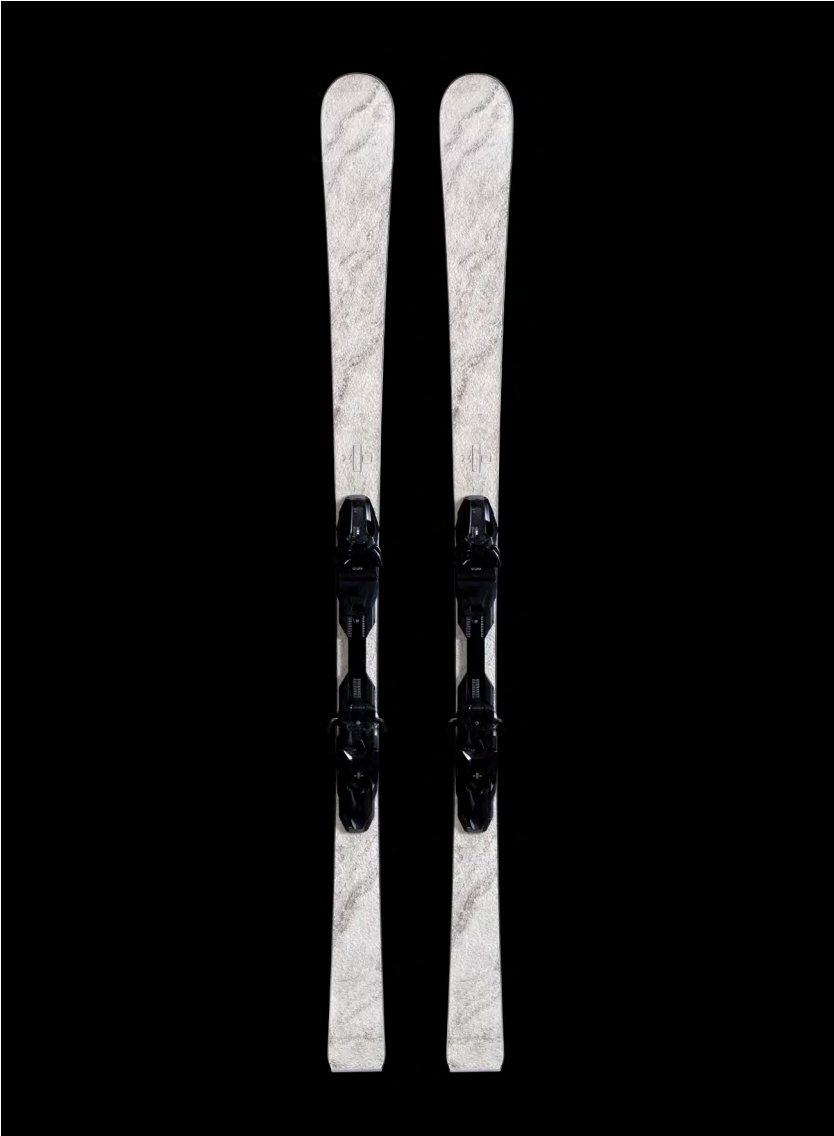

WHITE MARBLE

Marble is a stone of contrasts. Behind its delicate appearance lies great strength.

As a top sheet, marble provides natural dampening. It reduces vibrations and creates a calm ride – especially at higher speeds. Every marble slab is different. Its surface is finished in the zai workshop to bring the grain of the stone fully to life.

The zai Stone Marble is delivered with the Superflex binding plate and the zai by Tyrolia PRD12 Grip Walk binding system. The package includes zai carbon poles, a zai ski bag, as well as a two-year warranty and insurance. These are activated through specialist retailers or in the zai Experience Club.

BLACK MARBLE

With Black Marble, zai shows how nature and technology become one. A top sheet made from dark natural stone gives this ski not only its unmistakable aesthetic, but also its distinctive performance.

Black Marble impresses with its combination of dampening, flex and compressive strength. Vibrations are noticeably reduced – what remains is a calm, smooth ride with direct snow contact, even at high speed. The ski remains easy to turn, with precise grip – particularly on hard pistes. Every zai Stone Black Marble is unique.

The individual grain of the natural stone makes each model one of a kind. Robustness, skiing performance and a reduced, powerful design define this ski.

The zai Stone Black Marble is delivered with the Superflex binding plate and the zai by Tyrolia PRD12 Grip Walk binding system. The package includes zai carbon poles, a zai ski bag, as well as a two-year warranty and insurance. These are activated through specialist retailers or directly with the zai Experience Card.

SKI PACKAGE

The zai Ski Package brings together perfectly coordinated components: ski, binding, poles, Ski-Fix, ski bag, as well as two years of warranty and insurance.

The Ski Package is included with the following ski models: zai Blade, zai Wood and zai Stone Collection.

All zai models are equipped with the Superflex binding plate and the zai by Tyrolia PRD12 Grip Walk binding system.

The zai poles are made of carbon. Lightweight yet robust, they fit comfortably in the hand thanks to their ergonomic leather grip. They are available in eight lengths, from 105 to 135 cm.

The zai Ski-Fix keeps the skis securely together. It is made of natural rubber.

The custom-fit ski bag protects the skis and poles when travelling.

All components of the zai Ski Package are also available separately.



APPAREL

At zai, ski clothing serves the same purpose as the ski: it is made to perform and to last.

Good ski clothing does not follow fashion, but the demands of the mountain. It protects against cold, wind and wet while allowing the freedom of movement required for skiing.

zai SKI JACKET SKI PANTS

For its outer layer, zai uses wool fabrics from the Italian house Loro Piana. Wool provides warmth, breathes naturally and balances changes in temperature. Together with designer Michele Stinco of Polychromlab in Serafaus, zai developed a collection in which material, cut and function work together.

The jacket and pants are made from fulled wool fabric, a membrane and a microfibre lining. The fulling process makes the fabric dense, highly water-repellent and durable. The membrane provides additional protection from

the elements, while the cut and construction ensure the freedom of movement required. A functionally designed hood completes the jacket.

The ski jacket and pants are now available in two different fits: Waisted and Regular. The Regular version is available in Light Beige, Navy Blue, Black and Brown-Blue; the waisted version in Navy Blue.

The outer fabric consists of 90 percent wool, 5 percent silk, 3 percent elastane and 2 percent rubber.

The ideal garment for cold days or high-altitude tours: the zai Gilet. Worn over the zai ski suit, it protects skiers from cold and wind.

The Gilet is made from virgin wool and cashmere. This keeps the outer layer

breathable and creates a comfortable body climate. At the same time, the combination keeps the wind out. The Gilet combines style and function.

MIDLAYER

For exceptional performance on the mountain, we developed an exceptional insulating layer: the zai Midlayer. Cashmere and Merino fabrics from Loro Piana retain body heat, keeping you warm. When it gets warmer, Merino balances your temperature.

The Midlayer combines style and function. Precision and craftsmanship are reflected in the lightness and minimalism of its design. The special cut is not

only elegant, but follows the anatomy of the body and is slightly longer at the back. The hood protects the neck, which is particularly sensitive to cold, and enables a new freedom of movement. The shaped cuffs keep the hands warm through their form.

The Midlayer consists of 90% wool and 10% cashmere. It is available in Anthracite, Brown and Black.

Every accessory has a purpose. Together, they create a coherent overall design, considered down to the last detail.



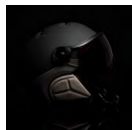

The zai ski helmet was developed in collaboration with the Italian manufacturer KASK. The double-lens visor is OTG-compatible (Over the Glass) and is therefore also suitable for people who wear glasses. The integrated active ventilation system allows the cooling airflow to be adjusted to the wearer's needs.

The ear pads now feature a black carbon look.

Developed by zai in collaboration with Komperdell for ski touring and freeriding, it features an extended grip that provides secure hold even when changing hand positions on the ascent. The extended grip zone allows for quick

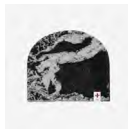
and easy repositioning on steep terrain and adjustment of the climbing aids without changing the pole length.

The zai Bernina is knitted by Herr Urs in Turgi, AG. The beanie's pattern is a

further development of the classic purl-stitch knitting technique.

What's interesting is that the zai Bernina and the zai Corvatsch are both based on the same mountain pattern. Yet, thanks to the refined knitting technique used for the Bernina, the two Beanies look completely different.
