



FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Financial Assistance Scholarship provides tuition relief for students who demonstrate financial need and artistic promise. The length and amount of the scholarship is based on individual circumstances and is awarded at the discretion of the administration. Applications are reviewed in April, July, and November. Recipients of the scholarship may apply for renewal on an annual basis for a maximum of four school years. The cash value of the scholarship is not subject to taxes.

APPLICATION DEADLINE AND PROCEDURE

- Applications are accepted throughout the year.
- An interview may be scheduled after all materials have been received.

REQUIREMENTS

- Completed application must be signed and returned to the Scholarship Manager.
- The Personal Statement/Plan of Study and Financial Information sections (page 2) must be completed.
- Most recent 1040 Federal Tax Statement. Please black out any reference to your Social Security/ Taxpayer Identification Number.
If Federal Taxes are not filed, please provide other documentation of current income.
- International students in F non-immigrant status and temporary visitors to the United States are not eligible for tuition relief scholarships.
