

**MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF CONTROL OF THE ART
STUDENTS LEAGUE OF NEW YORK, HELD
NOVEMBER 12, 2025, PURSUANT TO NOTICE DULY GIVEN, VIA ZOOM.**

1. The meeting was called to order at 6:05 pm by President Robin Frank

2. **Approval of Minutes**: The minutes of the previous meeting of the Board of Control, held October 15, 2025 were reviewed, and approved without edits.

4. **President’s Report**: President Robin Frank gave an update on an ongoing issue with Michael Pelleteri and his students. The Board discussed how to handle issues with students or the building.

6. **Building Committee**: Steve Rosenthal presented on behalf of the Building Committee. He gave an update on the facade cleaning progress, and noted that the League is renegotiating the Phase 2 contracts with Jack Gordon’s firm.

7. **150th Planning Committee**: Steve Durkee presented on behalf of the 150th Planning Committee. He noted that the committee is planning a second member event to tour Jack Howard-Potter's show.

8. **Collections Committee:** Robin Lechter-Frank presented on behalf of the Collections Committee. She highlighted new additions to the collection and noted that the committee is still deciding how to move forward with the Harvey Dinnerstein Estate.

9. **Membership Committee:** Yoko Cohen presented on behalf of the Membership Committee. She noted that members love the free Gallery Walks class.

10. **Development Committee:** Inga Glodowski presented on behalf of the Development Committee. She noted the success of the previous night's Gala and presented preliminary numbers. The gala exceeded projections by \$37,000, and with a preliminary total of \$490,000 raised, it was the second most successful Gala in League history.
