

OBTAINING THE FORM I-20

Certificate of Eligibility for F-1 Student Status

*The information on the following pages explains how to obtain the Form I-20.
Please read and follow the directions completely to avoid delays in getting your I-20.*

WHAT IS A FORM I-20 AND WHY DO YOU NEED ONE?

The I-20 is a government form that certifies your eligibility for F-1 nonimmigrant student status. That means that (1) you are or expect to be a “bona fide” student; (2) you meet the school's admissions requirements; (3) you will pursue a full course of study; (4) you proved to the school that you have the finances to study and live in the U.S. without engaging in unauthorized work or suffering economic hardship. **You need the Form I-20 to obtain the F-1 Student visa and nonimmigrant student status, or to remain in lawful F-1 status when transferring or changing schools within the U.S.**

RULES FOR OBTAINING YOUR FORM I-20

- 1. YOU MUST BE A “BONA FIDE” STUDENT, ACCEPTED TO ONE OF THE FULL-TIME FOUR-YEAR CERTIFICATE PROGRAMS OFFERED AT THE ART STUDENTS LEAGUE: FINE ARTS PAINTING, FINE ARTS PRINTMAKING, OR FINE ARTS SCULPTURE.**
- 2. YOU MUST PROVE THAT YOU CAN SUPPORT THE COSTS OF LIVING AND STUDYING IN THE U.S. FOR EVERY YEAR OF YOUR CERTIFICATE PROGRAM WITH THE ART STUDENTS LEAGUE. THIS IS REQUIRED BY THE U.S. GOVERNMENT IN ORDER TO ISSUE THE FORM I-20.**
- 3. DO NOT EXPECT THAT YOU WILL BE ABLE TO WORK IN THE U.S. TO HELP MEET YOUR ANNUAL COSTS.** On-campus employment is very limited; off-campus employment is strictly controlled by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.
- 4. CAREFULLY REVIEW OUR SCHOOL’S “ESTIMATED ANNUAL COSTS FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS” ON PAGE 2 OF THE APPLICATION TO CALCULATE YOUR “ESTIMATED ANNUAL COSTS.” THIS IS THE AMOUNT THAT YOU MUST SHOW PROOF OF FOR SUPPORT OF EVERY YEAR IN YOUR PROGRAM OF STUDY.** *(It will take four years for a certificate of completion in Fine Arts Painting, Printmaking, or Sculpture.)*
- 5. THESE REQUIREMENTS ARE NOT NEGOTIABLE.** The financial requirement represents a modest average budget that does not include luxuries of any kind. We strongly recommend that you budget at least 10% more if possible. Too little money may cause hardship and distress. Students and their families should look closely at the costs of living in New York City and studying at The Art Students League in the Certificate Program and make careful plans to ensure your needs will be met.
- 6. EXPECT ANNUAL INCREASES** in tuition and living costs of approximately 10%.
- 7. WE MAY HAVE TO ASK YOU TO GIVE US MORE PROOF OF YOUR FUNDING** – perhaps more than once. The U.S. government requires that we be sure, to the best of our ability, that you will have enough financial support during your studies.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR OBTAINING YOUR FORM I-20

- Complete the *I-20 Application*, including all required financial information (see below).
- If applicable, have your sponsor(s) complete the *Sponsor's Affidavit* and attach the required documentation.
- Submit your application, documentation, and sponsors' affidavits via email to tom@artstudentsleague.org. Do not send original documents. Keep the original documents for your visa interview.
- It is strongly recommended that you submit your I-20 application, evidence, and sponsor's affidavit at the same time as you are applying to the League's certificate program.

FUNDING SOURCES & EVIDENCE REQUIREMENTS

YOUR FUNDING CAN COME FROM ANY COMBINATION OF SOURCES IN THE U.S. OR ABROAD

1. **PERSONAL FUNDS** come from your own resources, not those of anyone else. If another individual transfers money to your bank account, that individual is your financial sponsor, and we will ask you to submit the evidence required of sponsors. Unless you have enough cash to support yourself for your entire program of study or can prove other sources of personal income, you will need a sponsor with an income sufficient to support you.
2. **FUNDS FROM "SPONSORS" (Parents, relatives, friends, organizations).** You may have as many sponsors as you need. Sponsors may provide you with support in the form of money and/or room and board. Free room and board means being offered lodging and not having to pay rent or for food.
 - It is highly recommended that **at least part of your financial support comes from your home country.** This helps when applying for your student visa!
 - **Sponsors should promise only as much money as they are capable of providing.** Some sponsors believe that the more money they promise the easier it will be to get your I-20. **THE MOST COMMON REASON WE REJECT FINANCIAL DOCUMENTS IS THAT WE DO NOT BELIEVE THE SPONSOR CAN AFFORD TO GIVE AS MUCH MONEY AS PROMISED.** Sponsors should promise only what they intend to give and only as much as can be afforded.
3. **FUNDS FROM THIS SCHOOL** Art Students League support (in the form of merit or work-study tuition scholarships) will **not** cover the entire program of study or all expenses, so you will need additional support to meet your minimum annual costs. Note: International students are not eligible for tuition relief scholarships (also known as the Financial Assistance Scholarship).

COMPLETE THE APPLICATION FOR THE FORM I-20 AND SUBMIT WITH ALL THE REQUIRED EVIDENCE OF FUNDING DIRECTLY TO THE INTERNATIONAL STUDENT SERVICES OFFICE VIA EMAIL TO tom@artstudentsleague.org (DO NOT MAIL ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS; KEEP THEM FOR YOUR VISA INTERVIEW).

ALL DOCUMENTS YOU PROVIDE MUST BE:

- **Not older than two months**
- **In English. (*We cannot review documents that are not translated into English.*)**

REQUIRED EVIDENCE OF FUNDING:

Proof of financial capability must show sufficient balance(s) of **liquid assets (cash)** currently available to cover one year of school and cost of living expenses.

A. **PERSONAL FUNDS:**

BANK/ASSET STATEMENT(S) IN YOUR NAME: Monthly Statements, not older than two months, of balances and deposits. Provide statements for the most recent six month period.

B. **SPONSORS OF CASH SUPPORT:**

1. **SPONSOR'S AFFIDAVIT AND EVIDENCE OF ANNUAL CASH SUPPORT.**

This form may be reproduced for each sponsor. All questions must be answered.

2. **PROOF OF INCOME.**

- Pay stubs for most recent six months
- Bank/investment statements for the last six months

Company Sponsor:

- Business registration
- Licenses
- Profit and loss statement

3. **BANK STATEMENT in the name of the sponsor *only*.** A monthly statement, not older than two months, of balances and deposits. Letters from bank officials will not be accepted in lieu of statements.

- **If there is no proof of income provided with a bank statement**, the statement balance will be totaled and divided by the number of years in your program of study to determine the amount available to you for each year.
- **The income of a company *is not* the personal income of the owner of the business** and will not be accepted as proof of income. The owner/sponsor must still provide proof of personal income.
- **If a bank statement is in the name of more than one person**, each individual must submit an affidavit of support.
- **We cannot accept bank statements that do not specify monthly balances and deposits!**

C. **SPONSORS OF FREE ROOM AND BOARD:**

This form should be completed by the individual who will provide you with free housing.

- **If you are presently in the U.S., you must be living with the sponsor** at the time of filing this application for this to be counted towards your means of support.

SPONSOR'S AFFIDAVIT EVIDENCE OF ANNUAL CASH SUPPORT

WHAT DOES THIS AFFIDAVIT MEAN?

By completing this affidavit, you are swearing to the U.S. government that you will provide this student with a specific amount of money, from your own financial resources, *for every year* he or she is going to study at The Art Students League of New York and live in the U.S. You are also proving that you can afford the support you are promising with the documentary evidence you have attached.

Before signing it, it is important to understand that you are making a financial commitment to the student that should not be broken. Sponsors who fail to provide the promised support force students to drop out of school and cause pain and suffering. Do not expect that the student will be able to help support the costs through employment. Employment is strictly controlled by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and very limited.

- Fill this form out in English (or have it officially translated). Promise only the amount of money you are able to give. The most common reason an affidavit is rejected is insufficient proof that a sponsor can afford to provide the promised funding.
- Sign and date the affidavit.
- Attach the supporting evidence listed below. ***ALL DOCUMENTS MUST BE ORIGINALLY IN ENGLISH OR OFFICIAL TRANSLATIONS INTO ENGLISH OF ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS.***
- The affidavit will not be accepted without the required supporting evidence.

- The student will need to keep the originals to present to a consular officer at the visa interview.

SPONSOR'S AFFIDAVIT PROOF OF FREE ROOM AND BOARD

WHAT DOES THIS AFFIDAVIT MEAN?

By completing this affidavit, you are swearing to the U.S. government that this student will live with you free of any charge for room and food *for every year* he or she is attending The Art Students League of New York. (The student cannot be required to provide you with any services such as, babysitting, cleaning, etc., in exchange for the room and board, as that is *employment*.) You are also proving that you are the person who owns or rents the property and can afford the support you are promising with the documents you have attached.

Before signing it, it is important to understand that you are making a financial commitment to the student that should not be broken. Sponsors who fail to provide the promised support force students to drop out of school and cause pain and suffering. Do not expect that the student will be able to help support the costs through employment. Employment is strictly controlled by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security and is very limited.

HOW TO COMPLETE THIS FORM:

- Fill this form out completely in English or have it officially translated into English.
- Sign and date the affidavit.
- Attach the supporting evidence listed below. The affidavit will not be accepted without the required supporting evidence.
- Give the student the original documents and have him or her submit them electronically or make photocopies to mail with the application for the Form I-20. The student will need to keep the originals to present to a consular officer at the visa interview.
