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PILOT SUMMARY

When Ella Goldman, a New York City Corporate attorney, gets engaged to her longtime boyfriend, Josh, she is ecstatic to embark on the next stage of her life. With a wedding to plan, and a blossoming career, Ella thinks she has it all. But when she suddenly loses her job and catches her fiancé cheating, her world comes crashing down. This devastating turn of events forces her to confront the truth about her life – and what it is she really wants. Convinced that this is a "wake-up call", Ella embarks on the journey to pursue her childhood dream of being an actress.

Ella finds little support for this new endeavor except from her friend Jackie, a former actress turned marketing executive. Her uptight upper east side, weight-obsessed sister Jocelyn thinks it's time to freeze her eggs and find a rich husband. Her mother, Margaret, urges Ella to reconcile with Josh. Her father, Robert, a lawyer himself, insists she apply for law jobs immediately. None of these solutions satiate Ella's desire to pave a new path of self-discovery. With her family and self-doubt breathing down her neck, Ella forges ahead and refuses to give up.

Meanwhile, in the land of opportunity, an actress dies on a Stone Studios set during production. As studio head Lacey Stone and her staff scramble to put out this fire, the industry speculates and the actresses vie for the chance to land the newly available role. Rising star Ava Thomas is thrilled, top casting director Ellen Day jumps at the chance to recast, and the hot director Jarred just wants to honor the memory of a lost talent. Simultaneously, Ella begins her study of the craft of acting from singing and dancing to meditation and animal work. She encounters other ambitious actors along the way as they all live out the day-to-day grind of making it big. Ella finds a vibrant new community where she meets desperate and wide-eyed Sabrina, cocky yet charming Jordan, and potential love interest Jonah.

In the final act, Ella faces her family over dinner. Their attempts to redirect her focus do nothing to shake her resolve. But when doors slam in Ella's face, will she have the strength to carry on?

CREATOR'S VISION

When I was a student at the University of Michigan I majored in political science, minored in history, and was on track to go to Law School. Once a college graduate, I started to question my future and what it was I really wanted to do with my life. After some soul-searching, I discovered my truth. I surprised my family and announced my decision to pursue a career as an actress. With no experience in the entertainment industry, I set out to learn the ins and outs of the business. My first job was as an NBC Page, and I was exposed to all aspects of television. From there I worked for some of America's most talented writers, directors, and producers. While I enjoyed every opportunity, my heart was always called back to my own creative endeavors.

EAST is a heightened version of my story – the heartbreaks, the failures, the dreams, the friendships, the wins, and the setbacks. It is a story about the pursuit of happiness and self-expression. I draw loosely from my own experiences and people I 've met along the way. I believe that anyone who has ever had a dream and dared to make it come true can relate to this journey.

A born and raised New Yorker, I spent time on both coasts but always yearned to create a show set in my hometown. The city has always inspired me – the energy, the diversity, the creativity, the passion and grit of its artistic community, and the tenacity of its people. I was always told if I wanted a career in the industry that I would have to live "out West". New York has it all: untapped talent, breathtaking locations, and inspiring stories. This is a love letter to whom and what makes this city the best – this is EAST.

Comedic yet poignant, EAST explores the trials and tribulations of Ella's adventure into show business. The show is fast-paced, witty, self-deprecating, and honest. The ensemble cast of characters will offer insight into this colorful and competitive world. 
CHARACTER BREAKDOWN
