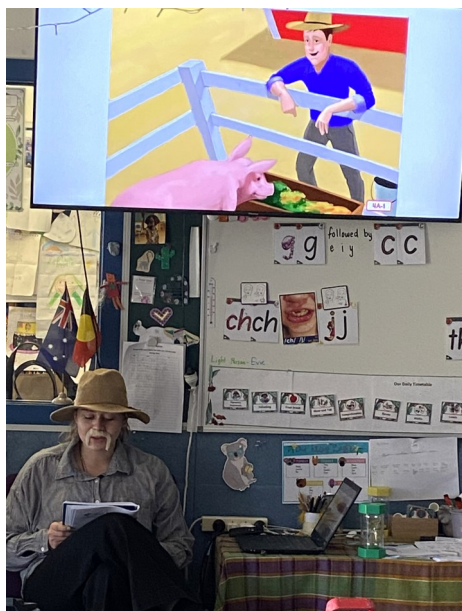
## AGTV - INDIVIDUAL POETRY COMPETITION

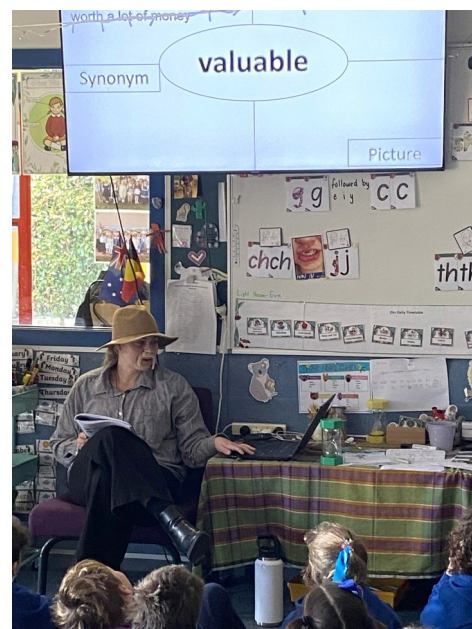

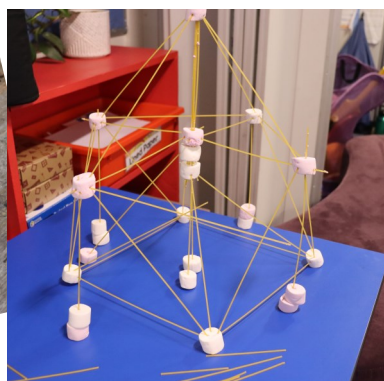
The students get so much enjoyment from these fun and engaging experiences, making their Literacy learning exciting, memorable and meaningful.
