Position Overview:

The primary focus of this position will be to support the social emotional, progress monitoring and assessment needs of the Multi-Intensive Autism Center opening in the 2026-2027 school year. The Social Worker works closely with the Leadership and Special Education team to ensure that the various aspects of the school are working together to ensure a safe and productive learning environment. The ideal candidate believes in Wyatt Academy's mission and is committed to fostering a strong sense of community while ensuring academic excellence.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provides direct support to students in the form of individual counseling, group counseling, conflict mediation, crisis intervention, academic advising, and/or classroom guidance lessons.
- Works in conjunction with the School Psychologist to provide mental health minutes for students with IEPs. Perform socio-emotional evaluations and write reports for students with IEPs. Coordinate Functional Behavioral Assessments (FBAs) and Positive Behavioral Intervention Plans (BIPs). Participate in IEP meetings as needed.
- Coordinates Social/Emotional Learning (SEL) supports.
- Maintains student records, such as referral date, documentation of student support services, and interventions.
- Guides the development and implementation of initial and ongoing referral, coordination, and follow-up of a variety of additional services for students (e.g., mental health services, after school programming, mentoring, etc.). Act as a point of contact for outside organizations working with students and their families.
- May serve as a member of the Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) team. Recommend, implement, and progress monitor socio-emotional and/or attendance interventions for students who are referred to MTSS.
- Works collaboratively with the SPED and Behavior Team to implement IEP/504 plans for the child within the school.

Qualifications:

- Master's degree in social work with a Colorado Department of Education Special Provider License - School Social Work
- Direct clinical experience with children ages 5 to 12 and families of diverse backgrounds, preferably in a school setting
- Experience or training in autism support and crisis intervention
- Ability to problem-solve and show initiative as a leader.
- Ability to form, coordinate and sustain community-based initiatives and/or school partnerships.

- Strong communication skills and cultural competency; ability to work closely with teachers, administrators, and district personnel.
- Familiarity with the social service agencies and organizations in Denver preferred.
- Demonstrated commitment and ability to work in a fast paced, intellectually and emotionally challenging school environment.
- Direct clinical experience with children ages 5 to 12 and families of diverse backgrounds
