By Train (fastest option)

- Time: ~20 minutes
- Frequency: Every 20–30 minutes
- Cost: 42-210 SEK

- UL Bus 801
 - Time: ~45 minutes
 - Frequency: Every 15-30 minutes
 - Cost: ~130 SEK
- FlixBus
 - Time: ~25-35 minutes
 - Frequency: Up to 5 times per day
 - Cost: From ~130 SEK

By Taxi

- Time: ~35 minutes
- Cost: Around 1,000 SEK
